The committee will review all proposals received after March 15th. All proposals must be received by August 15th to allow the committee time to review the proposal before the Petit Prix printing deadline.

Rules:

The 2010 Petit Prix Special Award Planning Committee must review and approve **ALL** Special Awards to be presented at the 2010 Petit Prix.

1. In case of duplicate proposals, the first one received will be the first reviewed.
2. Person sponsoring each Special Award must provide detailed criteria for awarding the prize at Petit Prix or the criteria stated on proposal application will be used.
3. Performance awards will be based on the six quarter-final qualifying runs.
4. All awards **MUST** be present at the Petit Prix by 8 A.M. Saturday morning unless other arrangements have been made with the Special Awards Chair. Awards may be shipped directly to: Petit Prix Special Awards, c/o Dolores French, 47513 294th Ave. SE, Enumclaw, WA 98022.
5. All Special Awards will be presented before the Semi-Final Rounds begin on Sunday.
6. All Special Award Proposal Sponsors will be notified by Sept 1st as to the status of their proposal.

Special Awards included at past Petit Prix have been divided into two categories: Participation Awards and Performance Awards. Participation Awards have included gift bags for a specific breed (poodles, westies, dachshunds, or All Americans) entered in the Petit Prix. Also an Oldest Dog Entered, Last Entry Received, and "Girls Just Want to Have Fun" Awards have been given to participants. Performance Awards are based on the performance of the dog in the six Quarter-final rounds using the criteria listed below unless another is stated in the application, e.g. High scoring breed, High Scoring Dog from a specific state, Fastest or Highest Scoring Dog in a specific game. Also Top Veteran Dog, Senior Handler and Junior Handler have had awards sponsored for them. Awards included baskets full of dog goodies, breed related items, gift cards to national dog supply places, plaques and trophies. Put on your creative caps and join the fun – what a great way to honor a friend, breeder or instructor or that special agility dog that has been in your life. Please remember as you plan your Special Award and the actual prize, that it should be one that would be an honor to receive at the TDAA National Petit Prix Tournament.

Dog will receive 1 point for each full second under time in each of the two Standard runs.

Ties will be broken by using the score of the quarter-final game What's My Line.
