This document is intended solely for active TDAA Member Clubs.

Overview

The objective of the TDAA Virtual League is to provide a mechanism for small clubs with modest local support to engage regularly in TDAA competition and to provide an avenue for competitors to qualify for the TDAA Petit Prix national tournament without the expense of travel.

In this league all participating clubs are invited to participate in a monthly competition. All clubs will compete on the same courses and play the same games under the same rules. Results for each club are rolled up as a single event.

Quick FAQ

- Participating clubs will *not* be required to submit a trial application fee for Virtual League events.
- The competitions are based on the size of the competition floor or field space. Consequently a number of different leagues may be spawned based on the size of the competition space.
- Dogs must be registered with the TDAA to participate
- The club must provide a local TDAA judge of record.
- A recording fee of \$1/run for all dogs.

Plan for 2018 Petit Prix

Initially we will be developing the League concept. The immediate plan is to provide a mechanism for a dog to qualify for the 2018 Petit Prix by earning qualifying scores in the Virtual League.

The top scoring dog in each jump height will be accorded the Teacup League Champion (TLCh) title. That score is comprised of the dog's combined scores through the conduct of the league.

2019 and Beyond

This unique approach to agility competition will require the input and expertise of participating clubs. The TDAA will rely on those clubs as a Steering Committee. The development of the league will be organic and will evolve under the shared experience of the participating clubs.
