Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar. **Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited in the ring and on the show grounds. Flex leashes are not to be used in the building.**

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all registered TDAA dogs under 20 inches over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE 6:00 p.m., July 10, 2017. Day of show entries will be accepted.

This trial will be held indoors with adequate a/c or fans to keep us comfortable.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

Please mark each of the following that apply:

- Move up from Beginners to: Intermediate Superior
- Move up from Games I to: Games II Games III

Submit \$8.00 with your move-up request, and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable.

Tag 10: The purpose of Tag 10 is to accumulate points in 10-point blocks and to accumulate as many of those 10-point sets as possible. The team starts with the first “Tag”, usually the performance of the tire, and then proceeds to gather a 10-point set. Upon successfully securing the 10-point set, the team must again Tag and seek to accumulate another 10-point set. The team continues in this fashion until time expires. Tag 10 is scored points then time.

Super Dog: Super Dog is a strategic dog’s-choice point accumulation game. In concept it is based on the old PACMAN computer game that if the smiley ate a "power pill", it could move faster and gobble up things in its path. After completing the power pill obstacle/sequence, the dog will earn bonus points for the next obstacles. Super Dog is scored points, then time.

Tunnel Jacks: Tunnel Jacks is played like the children’s game of jacks. The performance of a designated tunnel is the bounce of the ball. All other obstacles on the course are jacks and have specific point values. After the bounce the team begins with “onsies” then “twosies”...and all the way through “sevensies”, time permitting. Tunnel Jacks is scored points, then time.

Twelve Tone Row: Twelve Tone Row is a dog’s-choice game in which exactly 12 obstacles must be performed for points. Each obstacle has a different value; and sometimes a single obstacle has different values depending on the direction taken. The 12th obstacle is required to be an obstacle designated by the judge (usually the weave poles). Twelve Tone Row is scored points, then time.

Judge’s briefing on the day of trial supersedes any previous briefings.

Entries

Entries close at 6:00 pm on July 10, 2017, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are *not* acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are *not* acceptable. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

Class Information

Standard Class

BEGINNER AGILITY—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.
INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.
GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
GAMES III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

(But see rules for fast track titling.)

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division. Dogs may be entered in a lower height at the discretion of the handler. Dogs entered at a lower height will be scored with their measured height. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 2" for dogs 4" and under at the withers; dogs 4" or less with an exemption
- 4" for dogs 8" and under at the withers; dogs 12" or less with an exemption
- 8" for dogs 12" and under at the withers; dogs 15" or less with an exemption
- 12" for dogs 16" and under at the withers; dogs 17" or less with an exemption
- 16" for dogs 20" or less at the withers.

DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY HEIGHT SELECTED, BUT WILL BE SCORED WITH THEIR MEASURED HEIGHT.

ALL DOGS NOT POSSESSING A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD WILL NEED TO BE MEASURED PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF COMPETING AT THIS TRIAL. PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE MEASURING.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

WARM-UPS: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class.

MOVE-UPS: Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.
