ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all dogs 20" and under and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

SHOW SITE: The show site is located inside a pole building. The surface is ¾ inch horse mats on top of sand/clay mix (no cement). Please bring crates & water for your dog and clean up tools. **Note we can NOT accommodate X-Pens – crating space is limited.** Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Ribbons for new titles will be awarded. Fast Track dogs will only receive qualifying ribbons at the Beginner/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

Note: Handlers entering multiple dogs may spread pricing across all entries (i.e. pay for 8 classes – one dog runs in 3 classes, the other dog runs in 5 classes).

FEO (For Exhibition Only) Teams may switch their runs to FEO the morning of the trial, at the discretion of the club & trial secretary. Teams running FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times the standard course time in the ring. The dog may be on a leash as long as the handler is careful not to get it caught on any obstacles (no training allowed) while running FEO.

FEO runs are allowed in both Standard and Games classes in all levels.

FOOD: We will have a Potluck at lunch break Saturday & Sunday. Please bring a dish to pass. Table service provided; bottled water available for a donation.

Games Classes

(Sat) Heinz 57 – is a strategic dog’s choice point accumulation game. The purpose of the game is to score exactly 57 points using a doubling obstacle determined by the judge. *Heinz 57* is scored Points, then Time, with time as a tie-breaker only.

(Sat) Jumpers – is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up. *Jumpers* is scored Time, Plus Faults.

(Sat) Tunnel Vision – is a sequencing game that features only jumps and tunnels. The tunnels are arranged in “clumps” and must be performed with the handler at a modest distance. *Tunnel Vision* is scored Points, Minus Faults, then Time.

(Sun) What’s My Line – is a game of strategy in which the handler is required to direct his dog to perform every obstacle on the field once, but only once. *What’s My Line* is scored Points, Then Time.

(Sun) FAST - The Fifteen and Send Time class (FAST) is a dog’s choice point accumulation game, with a distance challenge that can be attempted at any time during the run. The name of the game tells the tale of the game: perform up to fifteen obstacles and attempt the send, and do it all under time. *FAST* is scored Points, then Time.

Further games information will be available at the trial. Games information is available in the Clean Run Book of Agility Games, 2nd Edition, by Bud Houston. The 3rd edition is available for purchase online as an electronic book at www.k9tdaa.com

Handicapped Handlers: Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in Standard and in qualifying course time in Games. A copy of the handler’s disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented at check in.

Class Information

Standard Class

BEGINNER AGILITY—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Obstacles to be used

Open (*Pipe*) Tunnel- 10’ (16” d) Tire – 19” diameter Table 3’ x 3’
AFrame -6’ 8” ramp (slats) Teeter-8’ (no slats) Dogwalk -8’ Planks (slats)
Weave poles – 24” spacing (6 poles)

Height Divisions

Measured heights are determined based on the height of the dog at the withers. Dogs of the same measured height compete at the same course times, even when jump heights differ. Dogs of the same measured height compete against each other. A dog’s owner or handler may enter a dog at any jump height desired. Consequently, no special provisions are made granting jump height exemptions (formerly body type exemptions) for dogs. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height.

2" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers.

4" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers.

8" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers.

12" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers.

16" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Notice to Exhibitors

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are NOT acceptable. Faxed entries and/or credit cards are not accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before July 10, 2017.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs at the trial site.

FAST TRACK

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, it is possible for the dog to move from Games I to Games III by qualifying in the lower two levels.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

Please mark each of the following that apply in the form below:

Move up from Beginner to: Intermediate Superior
Move up from Games I to: Games II Games III

Submit \$8.00 with your move-up request, and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each in standard and in games), and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for an earlier trial.

Agreement

I (We) acknowledge that the “Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules & Regulations” have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I(we) agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I(We) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time arising out of or in consequence of my(our) participation in this Agility Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Instructions

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to TDAA.
