## **DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE**

Four Seasons K9 Athlete Center is at 2 Painters Path, Washingtonville, OH. If your GPS does not accept that address use: 799 Main Street, Washingtonville, OH.

Painters Path is off of State Route 14. Four Seasons K9 Athlete Center is the only building on the road. You can't miss it!

Washingtonville is a speed trap. Do not drive over 35 mph. Painters Path has a speed limit of 5 mph to keep all dogs safe.

### **From the North**

Set your GPS for 2 Painters Path, Washingtonville, OH. You're going to look for Ohio 11 South, then Ohio 14 to Washingtonville, OH.

### **From the East**

Set your GPS for 2 Painters Path, Washingtonville, OH. You're going to look for PA I-76 West, then Ohio 14 to Washingtonville, OH.

### **From the South**

Set your GPS for 2 Painters Path, Washingtonville, OH. You're coming north on I-77, near Canton you'll look for US 62 East toward Alliance, which becomes Ohio 173, which becomes Ohio 14 to Washingtonville, OH.

### **From the West**

Set your GPS for 2 Painters Path, Washingtonville, OH. If you're on I-71, take the I-76, Ohio 224 exit and merge onto US 224, then take Ohio 14 to Washingtonville, OH.

### **Airports**

Washingtonville is approximately halfway between Pittsburgh and Cleveland, both of which have bustling airports. Columbus International Airport is a couple hours to the west of Washingtonville.

## Tournament Eligibility and Class Information

This trial is open to dogs having qualified in the Petit Prix Qualifying class, at any level of competition, measuring dogs 20" and under, over the age of 12 months. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical performance are not allowed.

Dogs eligible to play in the TDAA are defined in the [TDAA Rules and Regulations](#).

### Class Information

The Petit Prix tournament will include four standard courses and six games in the semi-final rounds. Standard courses will be run using Superior rules for performance, including rates of travel. Any qualifying score will be accorded at the dog's respective level.

The Petit Prix competition shall consist of these six games:

1. *Just In Time* is a dog's-choice point accumulation game in which the dog earns special bonuses for ending in a timely manner. *Just in Time* is scored Points, Then Time.
2. The *Steeplechase* is a numbered sequence typically featuring the A-frame and the weave poles (once of which must be taken twice). A *Steeplechase* is scored Time, Plus Faults.
3. *Pole Jacks* is a game of strategy and skill, played like the children's game of jacks. The performance of a short set of weave poles is the bounce of the ball! *Pole Jacks* is scored Points, Then Time.
4. *The Weakest Link* is a dog's choice point accumulation game that requires a handler to "bank" points to keep them; or lose points that are not banked. In this game points earned must be worth as much as or more than the last points earned; and are safe only when banked. Often there will be a distance challenge accorded an extraordinary bonus value. *The Weakest Link* is scored Points, Then Time.
5. *Jumplers* is a combined class of *Jumpers* and *Gamblers*. The dog will run a numbered course consisting of jumps and tunnels that will feature elements on which the dog will earn bonuses for working at a distance from the handler. *Jumplers* is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus.
6. *Quidditch* is a simple game of handling skill. The handler must direct the dog to perform three sequences of escalating value, attempting the simple performance of a tire after each. The game is full of interesting bonuses and colorful phraseology. *Quidditch* is scored Points, Then Time.

### Awards

Trial ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Tournament awards will be awarded: 1st through 5th place in each class; the TDAA National Agility Championship Title (TNAC) to the dog that: 1) achieves the highest overall score in each jump height at the TDAA Petit Prix, and 2) scores among the top 25 dogs in the tournament.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the Teacup Dogs Agility Association, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to crate outside. In cases of aggression/expulsion, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, verbal abuse of trial personnel, or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring, and possibly expulsion from the tournament.

Show hours are approx. 7:30 am to 6:00 pm Friday, Saturday and Sunday or until finished.

- ENTRIES CLOSE 6:00 p.m. September 10, 2018.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent payment to the TDAA shall be on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but 10% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before September 24, 2018.
