From I-94: Take I-94, Exit at #275, County F, Ixonia-Sullivan. (This is about 6 miles west of the Oconomowoc exit which is HWY 67.) Go North on County F about 4 miles. Go West on Elmwood Dr (County P) which is just before the train tracks. Go right on Cedar Drive. The building is at the end of the drive on the left.

From the East: Take Hwy 16 (to about 5 miles west of Oconomowoc). Go South on County F in Ixonia. Turn right on Elmwood (County P) which is right after the railroad tracks. Turn right on Cedar Drive. The building is at the end of the drive on the left.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of an agility jump will be provided. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class each day.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a test up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Bitches in season are not permitted in the test. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Eligibility: This test is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs under 17" at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Test. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

Volunteer signups will be taken at the trial

Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the trial site, if caught not cleaning up you will be asked to leave without of refund for the remainder of the test.

FOOD: Lunch is available at the test for a nominal fee.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

TDAA now offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO teams will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.

Games Classes

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing. Games Descriptions (For more detailed descriptions, see The Clean Run Book of Agility Games, 2nd Edition by Bud Houston . The book is available at Clean Run website : www.cleanrun.com or through www.dogagility.org

Snooker p.138 Snooker is a two-part game with an opening and closing sequence. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. *Snooker is scored points then time.*

Basketball p.19 Basketball is a two part game. The first part is the point accumulation period and in the second part, point scores can be multiplied. Two jumps are marked SD for Sudden Death. If the dog takes these jumps, he/she must run to the table to stop time. The dog retains any previously scored points, but cannot earn any more points. *Basketball is scored points and then time.*

Trim the Tree p.161-2 As in Gamblers, the object of this game is for the dog and handler team to accumulate as many points as possible in a specified time. However, in Trim the Tree, the handler must hang a Christmas ornament on the tree after each obstacle is successfully completed for points. *Trim the Tree is scored points plus ornaments, then time.*

Octagon Game p.114 Starting at the 12 o'clock jump, dog and handler must perform all jumps in a serpentine fashion in the direction designated by the judge. If the dog knocks a bar, crosses the line of poles in the center of the octagon, or refuses a jump, the dog must do the weave poles. The correct weave pole entry is the entry closest to the point of the mistake. Weaves poles will be required in games 1, there are no refusals at the jumps faults are off course or knocked bar. *The Octagon Game is scored time only.*

By competing in this TDAA trial, you and this dog are eligible to enter this tournament. Additional information and the premium list will be available at www.k9tdaa.com later this year. We hope you will consider joining us for this fun event.

The following is a list of obstacles:

The following is a list of obstacles to be used at this trial: A-frame 6'8" (with is 30") with slats, 8' foot dog walk without slats, Teeter 12" (with 11") without slats, Closed, collapsed tunnel 18", Open (pipe) tunnels 16", 36" table, Tire jump, weave poles, single and winged jumps.

All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 17" and under at the withers jumps 16"

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

Jump Height Exemptions

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

Standard Class

Beginning Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginning Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Entries close at 6:00 PM November 21st, 2009, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Test. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Test Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Day of event entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$3.00 per run/per day. Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no less than 30 minutes before the judge's first briefing.

TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies at each of the lower levels.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he/she received the qualifying score.
