ELIGIBILITY: This trial is open to all dogs 17 inches and under, and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness, which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. All dogs do not have to be registered with TDAA before the trial. Dogs can register for TDAA on day of trial and send registration with trial paperwork. These dogs will have pending numbers until their TDAA number is presented.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in a designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

A Copy of your dog's Jump Height Card must be attached to the premium or be presented at check-in. The judge must measure any dog without a jump height card before they can run.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Exhibitors are responsible for using the designated dog exercise area & picking up after their dogs.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: There are many fast food restaurants within a mile of the show site.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. There will be a prize for all qualifiers in all classes.

Site Availability: Building will open at 6pm on Friday, December 11th and 7am on Saturday & Sunday, December 12-13. Overnight indoor crating space & set-up available Friday & Saturday. Dogs cannot be left overnight. Exhibitor assumes all responsibility for items left overnight at the trial site.

ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS

- Your dog's Jump Height Card must be attached to the premium or be presented at check-in. Any dog without a jump height card must be measured before they can run.
- **TDAA agreement must be returned along with each entry.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, weather, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in Season are **not** permitted in the trial or in the building. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter before December 9, 2009. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.

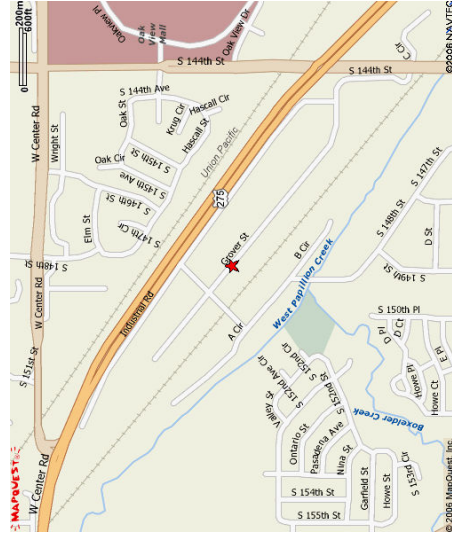

- A-Frame (with slats, 6'8"); Closed (*Collapsed*) Tunnel & Open (*Pipe*) Tunnel (Teacup size);
- Teeter (slatless, 8"); Table, 3'x3"; Tire Jump (teacup size); Weave Poles (21" spacing)
- Single and Winged Jumps (teacup size); Dogwalk (8' boards, 12" wide with slats)

Class Information

STANDARD CLASS:

BEGINNER AGILITY—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agility Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES CLASS:

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground + height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height. Dogs without a TDAA height card will need measured at the trial.

- 4" jump height - Restricted to dogs measuring 8 inches and under at the withers
- 8" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 12 inches and under at the withers
- 12" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 15 inches and under at the withers
- 16" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 17." or less at the withers.

GAMES CLASSES

BEAT THE CLOCK

The objective is for the team to perform the clock of obstacles before the time runs out. Typically, the standard course time is 60 seconds.

HEINZ 57

Purpose of this game is to score 57 points as quickly as possible. The tire is a doubling obstacle which can be taken only twice. This is a handlers choice game and is scored points then time.

GAMBLERS

The objective of Gamblers is for the dog and handler team to accumulate as many points as possible in a specified time and then to perform a designated gamble, also within a specified time, which consists of a sequence of obstacles that requires the dog and handler to work some distance apart.

Miniature Golf

There are three courses on the field. Each course begins with a different tunnel. The dog will run whichever course based on which tunnel the dog goes through first. All sequences have the same course time, regardless of the disparity of difficulty. Score is based on time plus faults. Lowest score wins.

Jumpers CDS (Call, Direct, Send)

In this game, the handler must call, direct and send his dog to perform three series of obstacles. The complexity of each challenge is based on the level at which the team is competing.

Disclaimer: Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will discuss in more detail the game techniques.

Fast Track Move-Ups

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III by earning qualifying scores at the lower levels.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.**

Submit \$8.00 with class move-up request and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have four chances at each), and is non-refundable.

AGREEMENT

I (We) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Agility Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above in consideration of the acceptance of this entry. I (We) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Teacup Dogs Agility Association in the premium list for this agility trial, or both, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed on the reverse side of this entry form. I (We) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and agreement.
