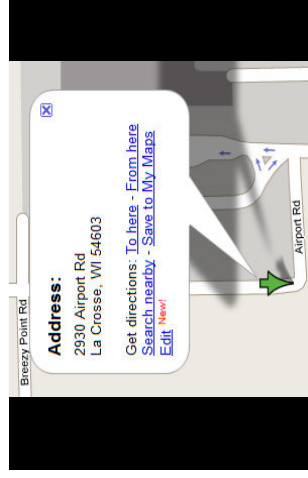

Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site.

In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the trial site

Eligibility:

This trial is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs under 17" at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

Height order: tall to small small to tall tall to small

Measuring for all dogs without a permanent jump height card will be available from 8:00 to 8:30 am on Sat., and Sun. There will be a general briefing at 8:45 am on Sat & Sun to familiarize all participants with TDAA rules. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will follow general briefing, with spare equipment in the warm-up area. Judging will start at 9:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

NEW Class

FEO – TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class.

FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. "FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their run."No treats or food allowed in ring.

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing.

Games Classes & Descriptions:

Connect the Dots- The purpose of this game is for the dog to accumulate as many points as possible in the allotted time by connecting the dots. The "dots" are the contact obstacles. The dog earns points for each obstacle performed in a line which is the series of obstacles from dot to dot. This game is scored points then time.

Last of the Mohicans - The purpose of this game is to stay in motion through a small course. The dog will earn one point for each obstacle performed. The dog with the most points wins. The handler is not allowed to stop their movement or they are considered dead and all points are lost.

Colors - The objective of this game is to successfully negotiate one of three overlapping mini courses. The handler may choose which course to run. Colors is scored faults then time.

Contact Donut - The objective of this game is to accumulate as many points as possible by running a circular course composed of tunnels and contacts within 30 seconds. Bonus points are awarded if the handler can stay within the donut hole while the dog runs the course from start to finish.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of an agility jump & spare equipment will be provided for all exhibitors with additional equipment when available. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class each day.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

“Obstacles to be used”

The following is a list of obstacles:
 A-Frame (6'8"ramp) Weave Poles (18" centers) Table (36"X36")
 Closed (collapsed) Tunnel Single and Winged Jumps Tire Jump (16")
 Open (pipe) Tunnel Dog walk (8' ramp) Teeter (8' ramp)
 All contact obstacles are slatless
 All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements.

Warm-ups – a warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump and other equipment as available, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

“Measured Jump Height”

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then

The dog can jump at the next lower height.
 • 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
 • 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
 • 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
 • 17" and under at the withers jumps 16".

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

Jump Height Exemptions:

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.
Intermediate Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginning Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Entries:

Entries close at 6:00 PM Feb 22nd, 2010, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries **without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable**. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

Day of event entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$3.00 per run/per day. **Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no less than 30 minutes before the judge's first briefing.** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he/she received the qualifying score.

"Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies at each of the lower levels."
