CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. (Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.)

Games Classes

Games I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class

How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. You must submit a copy of title certificates for each dog. Fast tracked dogs are not eligible for placement or title ribbons, but are eligible to receive Q ribbons.

Submit \$8.00 for each dog's move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. If you have fast tracked before at a previous trial but have not moved up to the equivalent level based on titles earned through another organization, you may fast track at this trial without sending additional payment.

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing. Games Descriptions (For more detailed descriptions, see The Clean Run Book of Agility Games, 2nd Edition by Bud Houston . The book is available at Clean Run website : www.cleanrun.com or through www.dogagility.org All weaves are optional for beginners, with the only exception would be for the pairs game if all dogs on that team are games 1 somebody has to do them. There are no weaves at all in baseball and barrel racing.

Hugs and Kisses (Copy Cat)

Hugs & Kisses is a dog's choice game. Repeating obstacles of the same type is not allowed

Scoring is points then time. A start finish line will be used, with time as a tie breaker.

Ying & Yang (Strategic Pairs)

This is a 2 dog handler game in which you work as a team to complete the numbered course. Talking to your team mates and outside assistance from the crowd is encouraged. Judge Christina wants cheering!!!

**Please list your Ying & Yang (Strategic Pairs) partner on entry form or we will assign one for you. 4" & 8" may jump together with 4" being the bar height, 12" & 16" may jump together with 12" being the bar height.

Scoring is time only, so you must be under your standard course time.

Heart (Baseball)

This is a numbered course that looks like a heart. A containment line will be drawn and a pacemaker (table) will be put in the middle of the heart. Goal to do the numbered course behind the line or on the pacemaker.

Scored time plus faults, minus bonuses.

Heart beat (Barrel Racing)

This is a simple TIGHT course that is modeled after a heart beat. There are 4 tunnels and you must complete all tunnels in correct order. If you fault the course you have a heart attack and you must start over again with number one.

Scored time only.

THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF OBSTACLES TO BE USED: The Following is A List of Obstacles to be used at this trial: 6'8" A-Frame with cleats, 8' Dogwalk without cleats, 8' Teeter without cleats, 16" Closed (Collapsed) Tunnel, 16" Open (Pipe) Tunnels, 36" Table, Tire Jump, Weave Poles, Single and Winged Jumps

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 17" and under at the withers jumps 16"

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

JUMP HEIGHT EXEMPTIONS: Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Test Committee, be asked to leave the Test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors MUST pick up after themselves and their dogs at the TEST site and at the HOTELS. If caught not cleaning up they will be asked to leave for the remainder of the Test with out a refund.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the test. The club will refund all but five dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Test Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) if requesting a refund after the closing date of February 6th, 2010.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Maximum Course may be enforced at this Test.

ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all teacup dogs measuring 17 inches or less at the withers., over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

YOUR DOG MUST BE REGISTERED IN TDAA TO PARTICIPATE IN TEST. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

Volunteer signups will be taken at the trial

Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the trial site, if caught not cleaning up you will be asked to leave without of refund for the remainder of the test.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY); TDAA now offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO teams will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.
