DIRECTIONS

From Nashville: Take 24W toward Clarksville; Exit at New Hope Road - Exit 31; at the end of the ramp, turn left onto New Hope Road; go 1.7 miles; turn right at flashing light onto Old Clarksville Pike; go approximately 1 mile; turn left onto Bearwallow Road and go approximately 1.4 miles and turn onto

gravel driveway on right at 2917 Bearwallow Road and follow driveway to the barn, approximately 500 yards.

From Clarksville: Take 24 E toward Nashville; Exit at New Hope Road and continue directions from above.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules and Regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times EXCEPT when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up areas. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any Exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial Site. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Refunds will be given to bitches in season, up until the trial start. Letter from veterinarian will suffice. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

Obstacle Familiarization – obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday mornings 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs. Familiarization - one time per dog.

Warm-ups – a warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all Exhibitors.

TDA – uses scaled-down equipment on a proportionally set course. All obstacles will be on small-dog scale. See <http://www.k9tada.com> for details.

Show Site – site is indoors on agility rubber matting with a ring of approximately 70 feet x 60 feet.

Eligibility – this Trial is open to all dogs 17-inches and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups – Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing, but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-Up Request Form" set out later in premium and available on Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Fast-Track dogs *are not* eligible for awards in classes through which they Fast-Track. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered. Each dog entered will receive a toy on the day they check in (either Saturday or Sunday).

CLASS INFORMATION

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL, SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS.

Games Classes

Dare to Double – Dare to Double is a dog's choice game, which means that the dog will earn points for taking obstacles in the order and direction of his/her handler's choosing. The A-Tame is the doubling obstacle and may be performed at any time and as many times as the handler wishes. To keep all points accumulated on course, the team must get to the table or finish line (as designated by the Judge) before course time elapses or the team loses half its points.

Tunnel Snooker – Snooker is a game of strategy and teamwork and is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. In the opening sequence, the Game begins with an opportunity for the team to earn points by successfully performing red obstacles (jumps) valued at 1 point each. In Tunnel Snooker, tunnels are used instead of "red" obstacles (jumps). A successful performance earns the team the right to attempt one of the colored (non-red) obstacles on the course, valued at 2 to 7 points. Successful performance earns the points for the selected "colored" obstacle. After the opening, in the closing sequence, the team will perform all colored obstacles in the numerical sequence indicated by their point value.

Blackjack – The purpose of this Game is to accumulate 21 points based on the assigned point value to each obstacle in the fastest time. Accumulating more than 21 points disqualifies the team.

Jumpers CDS (Call, Direct, Send) – Jumpers CDS is a combination of a Jumpers course and a Gamblers course. A handler must call, direct and send his/her dog to perform three series of obstacles. The three separate distance challenges in this Game include: a call over one to three obstacles; a Direct or mid-course distance challenge of two to five obstacles; and a Send portion over two to three obstacles to close out the game.

Entries

Entries close at 6:00 p.m. on March 17, 2010, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up and until 8:00 a.m.** each morning, for an additional fee of \$8.00 per dog, per day. TDAADog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAADog Agility Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAADog Agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Standard Class – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this Class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But, see Rules for Fast-Track titling.)

BEGINNER AGILITY – Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY – Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

Games Class –

GAMES I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see Rules for Fast-Track titling.)

GAMES II – Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

GAMES III – Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs - will be allowed. Teams running FEO will have a maximum of 1.5

times the Standard Course time in the ring. The dog may be on a leash, as long as the handler is careful not to get it caught on any obstacle while in the ring. Teams may not repeat any contact obstacles (no training allowed) while running FEO. FEO runs do not count toward TDAADog title or certificates. *No treats or food allowed in ring.*

Height Divisions –

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division, will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a Judge. To figure leg to shoulder ration: height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement, then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 4" for dogs 8" and under at the withers; dogs 12" or less with an exemption
- 8" for dogs 12" and under at the withers; dogs 15" or less with an exemption
- 12" for dogs 15" and under at the withers; dogs 17" or less with an exemption
- 16" for dogs 17" or less at the withers.

PLEASE SEND A COPY OF YOUR HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY OR BE PREPARED TO PRESENT IT AT CHECK IN.

ALL DOGS NOT POSSESSING A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD, WILL NEED TO BE MEASURED PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF COMPETING AT THIS TRIAL. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO ARRIVE EARLY ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE MEASURING.

Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III by earning qualifying scores in Games I and then in Games II. Dog's owner *must* submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

I/We agree to hold the TDAA, TDAA approved Judge and TN-Tucky Low Riders, Inc. (TTLR) harmless from any legal claim resulting from said Judge's action under the TDAA Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I/We agree that TTLR has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I/We agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
