Routes to the Trial

FROM ARIZONA: Hwy. 93 North. After you cross over into Nevada, merge onto I-11 North. After 7 miles, take exit 23 to merge onto I-215 West. After 12 miles, exit 12B to I-15 South toward Los Angeles. Keep right and merge onto Blue Diamond Rd. Get into left lane and turn left on Dean Martin Dr. In 1.3 miles turn right on Torino. House is the 3rd on left. (3295 W Torino Ave)

FROM UTAH: Interstate I-15 South to Blue Diamond Rd. Go right (west) on Blue Diamond Rd and get immediately into the left lane. Turn left on Dean Martin Dr. In 1.3 miles turn right on Torino. House is the 3rd on left. (3295 W Torino Ave)

FROM CALIFORNIA: Stay on I-15 North to Exit 31 Silverado Ranch Blvd. Turn left on Silverado Ranch Blvd. Turn right onto Dean Martin Dr. Go 1.2 miles and turn left on Torino. House is the 3rd on left. (3295 W Torino Ave)

Games Classes

(The Judges Briefing supersedes any published briefing for the games.)

DOUBLE OR NOTHING is a dog's choice point accumulation game exactly like traditional gamblers except there are two possible gambles. The first gamble is for the qualifying score; the second gamble is... double or nothing. Double or Nothing is scored points, then time.

WEAKEST LINK The objective of The Weakest Link is to score as many points as possible in the allotted time. Only "banked" points will count toward the final score. Points are banked when the dog gets on the obstacle specified by the judge as the "banking" obstacle. The dog and handler team have 60 seconds to accumulate the best score possible.

GO FOR BROKE - This game is played opposite traditional gamblers. This game starts with a gamble which must be completed with the handler behind the closest containment line. (No points are earned for the gamble.) If completed successfully, this allows the team to go on to accumulate points.

BEAT THE CLOCK - Beat the Clock is a sequencing game in which the obstacles are arranged in four parts, like quadrants of the clock. Obstacles are typically arranged around the tire. The handler is required to do the tire before each of the quadrants. Beat the Clock is scored points, then time. The judge's briefing, given 15 minutes prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions of how to play the game.

JUMPLERS - Jumplers is a combined class of Jumpers and Gamblers. The dog will run a numbered course consisting of jumps and tunnels that will feature elements on which the dog will earn bonuses for working at a distance from the handler. Jumplers is scored Time, Plus Faults minus bonus.

IMPOSSIBLE TUNNELS - the Impossible Tunnel Game is a numbered sequence which features a wicked tangle of tunnels. Obstacles other than tunnels may be used. The Impossible Tunnel Game is scored time, plus faults..

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

Further games information will be available at the show. *The judge has the right to alter the rules.*

ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20" or less and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

CHECK-IN

Check in on Saturday & Sunday: 6:30 am to 7:30 am; judges briefing to follow.

Judging starts at 8 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

WARM-UPS

A warm-up, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

NOTICE to EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. There will be a supervised obstacle familiarization.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. A refund of 50% will be given for withdrawals due to bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian will be required by the first day the dog is competing during the event weekend. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after this first day.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on Official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$35 service fee will be charged for any returned checks.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

TDAA rules now allow a dog to wear a collar with tags, clothing, or other adornment unless they pose a safety concern. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. Exhibitors may wear clothing or insignia of their training group.

TDAA Registration of each entered dog is required. If your dog does not have a TDAA registration number yet, please complete the Registration form, and submit fee with trial entry.

Entries close at 6 p.m. Friday, January 17, 2020 and cannot be cancelled, altered or substituted after that time. Entries received after 6 p.m. Friday, January 17, 2020 will be considered as Day of Show entries and subject to the higher Day of Show fees.

Volunteers

Signups for volunteers will be done at the time of the trial.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper measured height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered at any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a higher height division from their measured height will be scored in the higher height division. Dogs that run at a lower height than their measured height will be scored with dogs of their measured height. Special provisions for Jump Height Exemptions that are based on a dog's structure are explained in detail at <http://www.k9tdaa.com>. Click on rules and go to section 3.5 Jump Heights.

- 2" – restricted to dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less at the withers.
- 4" – restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less at the withers.
- 8" – restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less at the withers.
- 12" - restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less at the withers.
- 16" - open to all dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Class Information

Standard class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Game Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

A copy of your TDAA height card must accompany your trial application or be presented at check-in. If you do not have a TDAA height card your dog must be measured.

If this is your first time entering a TDAA trial and you have not received a TDAA number, please write "pending" on the entry form in place of the TDAA number.

SIGNING UP

If your dog does not have a TDAA number, the Dog Registration Form is on the last page of this premium list.

You may still enter our trial weekend; simply put "Pending" on the entry form and include a copy of this Registration form with your entry, along with the additional \$12.00 fee.
