

TRIAL GAMES DESCRIPTION:

FULLHOUSE:

Full House is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Full House is scored Points, Less Penalty, Then Time. ER6

BLACKJACK

Blackjack is a dog's-choice game in which the dog is directed to accumulate 21 points in the fastest time; going over 21 points disqualifies the team. During point accumulation the dog must score at least one obstacle from three obstacle types. Blackjack is scored Points, Then Time. ER10

JOKER'S WILD

Jokers Wild is a distance game that features several distance challenges of increasing complexity. As each gamble is mastered the dog moves on to the next! The dog that scores the most points is the winner. Joker's Wild is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Obstacle Familiarization will be provided on the morning of the trial prior to judging for dogs and handlers.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Small rosettes awarded for Titles/Masters. Large rosette and ornament for Championships. Team of the Day Award is awarded to the highest qualifying team (ties broken by time).

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

All dogs must be kept on leash except in the agility ring.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior or from Games I to Games III on the same day. The dog must qualify first in Beginner and again in Intermediate or Games I and Games II. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with this FAST TRACK Move-Up Request form. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. The Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for previous trials. The team is not moved up until the fee has been paid.

Disabled Handlers – Disabled handlers will be given additional time amounting to 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard classes and 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. A copy of the handler’s disabled parking tag or other official documentation shall be sent with the entry or provided at check-in as proof of disability.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must always be on leash or crated except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of Nature, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No refunds after closing date unless accompanied by a veterinarian's note indicating lameness or illness. At that time, up to 50% of the trial fees may be returned.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. Height divisions are as follows: **Note: It is no longer necessary to present a jump height card when entering a TDAA trial. A dog's owner or handler may enter a dog at any jump height desired.** Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. For scoring, heights are listed below:

4" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

8" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 15" or less.

12" jump height – restricted to dogs measuring 15" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less.

16" jump height – restricted to dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers. Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

E1 - Long backed dogs – The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

E2 - Weight to length provision (by structure, not obesity) – This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

E3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs – This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs is based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs. A dog also may be given a waiver to jump at a lower height even though he does not meet any of the criteria for a jump height exemption. A waiver will be given to a dog for extraordinary circumstance. Dogs given a waiver to a lower jump height will be able to earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles.

Eligibility – This trial is open to all dogs under 17" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

TDAA offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their chosen jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 times of the SCT.

MAINLY AGILITY COVID-19 RULES and waiver for Private Lessons and Group Classes and Events

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- 1) If you or anyone in your household has had any symptoms of the COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days – DO NOT COME.
- 2) If you or anyone in your household has been in contact with someone diagnosed with the COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days – DO NOT COME.
- 3) If you or anyone in your household have traveled out of state for an extended period of time – DO NOT COME. If you're not sure about this, contact me and we can discuss.
- 4) Check your temperature before coming. If it is 100 or higher – DO NOT COME.
- 5) One dog – One handler.....NO guests or spectators.
- 6) Minimize what you need to bring inside for class.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE TRAINING CENTER

- 1) There is a Porta-Potty to the left of the front door. The bathrooms in the building will not be open to public. The Porta-Potty is equipped with a hand sanitizer.
- 2) Do not park in the area between the front door and the Porta-Potty.
- 3) Everyone will be entering through the front door (not the side door that we normally use). Exit will be through one of the side doors on the left side of the training area.

OTHER COVID-19 CHANGES AT THE TRAINING CENTER

- 1) You must maintain a minimum of 6' between you and anyone else at all times.
- 2) Face coverings are required inside the building at ALL times, including when you are running your dog, no exceptions.
- 3) The crate room is closed but indoor crating is allowed ringside.

4) Mainly will supply chairs in each "social distancing" corral. Do NOT bring your own chair.

5) Bring your own water for your dog. You may not use the bathrooms to get water. No water given to your dog ringside.

6) You're responsible for your dog's poop. There will not be a community "poop bucket".

7) Students are not allowed to have food or beverage inside the training area.

8) There will be hand sanitizer available.

9) Sanitize your hands before and after touching any of the agility equipment...weave wires, jump bars, tunnel bags etc

10) No handling of someone else's dog allowed. No dog/dog interaction allowed.....inside or out.
