Routes to the Trial

FROM ARIZONA: Hwy. 95 North to the northwest end of Las Vegas and take Ann Rd. exit, left off exit, go west on Ann Rd. to Riley (2 blocks), right on Riley, right on La Mancha. Go to gravel driveway on right (8565 La Mancha).

FROM UTAH: Hwy. I-15 to Hwy. 215, go west (right) on 215 to Durango, turn left (south) onto Durango, drive south to Ann Rd. and turn right, go west on Ann Rd. to Riley (2 blocks), right on Riley, right on La Mancha. Go to gravel driveway on right (8565 La Mancha).

FROM CALIFORNIA: Stay on I-15 North to Hwy. 95 North. Hwy. 95 North to the northwest end of Las Vegas and take Ann Rd. exit, left off exit, go west on Ann Rd. to Riley (2 blocks), right on Riley, right on La Mancha. Go to gravel driveway on right (8565 La Mancha).

Games Classes

(The Judges Briefing supersedes any published briefing for the games.)

Penny Arcade Penny Arcade is a dog's choice point accumulation game. The course contains one or more "arcade games" which grant performance point multipliers allowing for high scores for the skillful and intrepid. Penny Arcade is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Quidditch Quidditch is a simple game of handling skill. The handler must direct the dog to perform several sequences of escalating value, and attempting the simple performance of a tire after each. The game is full of interesting bonuses and colorful phraseology. Quidditch is scored Points, then Time. ER2

Wild West Pinball Wild West Pinball is a dog's choice point accumulation game. A number of obstacles are set aside on the course with extraordinary value. The handler is obligated to direct his dog to score and pick up as many of those high value obstacles as possible. Wild West Pinball is scored Points, then Time. ER2

Dare To Double Dare To Double is a dog's choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course (traditionally the A-frame) as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the A-frame is faulted! The dog must get to the finish obstacle before course time elapses or be penalized. Dare To Double is scored Points, then Time. ER2

Snooklers Snooklers is a point accumulation game with elements of both Snooker and Gamblers. Like Snooker, there is an opening and a closing sequence. Rather than the traditional "red hurdle" the "reds" are modest distance challenges. Otherwise the game works just like Snooker. Snooklers is scored Points, then Time. ER2

Tunnel Crossover Sunday Variation The Tunnel-Crossover game is a follow-the-numbers game with a touch of distance work. Four tunnels creating a crossover effect create a zone through which the handler is not allowed to move. Consequently, the handler must work the course from outside the crossover arrangement. The Sunday Variation has only tunnels. The Tunnel-Crossover Game is scored Time only. ER2

Petit Prix Qualifier Qualifying rounds for the Petit Prix Tournament are being held at this event. The Tournament Rules may be downloaded on the Internet at www.k9tdaa.com, and are hereby incorporated by reference. All dogs registered with the TDAA are eligible to enter the Qualifying round, without regard to level of competition. The Qualifying round will be judged under Superior rules for performance, using Superior rates of travel. Body type and veterans height exemptions shall be scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. Exemptions for "Self-declared" heights will not be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament. PLEASE NOTE: Qualifications earned in these qualifying events are recorded for titling at the level for which the dog is eligible.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

Further games information will be available at the show. *The judge has the right to alter the rules.*

ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20" or less and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

CHECK-IN

Check in on Friday: 5 pm to 6 pm, Saturday & Sunday: 6:30 am to 7:30 am; judges briefing to follow.
Judging starts at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, 8 a.m. on Saturday and 8 a.m. on Sunday.

WARM-UPS

A warm-up, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

NOTICE to EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. There will be a supervised obstacle familiarization.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. A refund of 50% will be given for withdrawals due to bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian will be required by the first day the dog is competing during the event weekend. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after this first day.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on Official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$35 service fee will be charged for any returned checks.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

TDAA rules now allow a dog to wear a collar with tags, clothing, or other adornment unless they pose a safety concern. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. Exhibitors may wear clothing or insignia of their training group.

TDAA Registration of each entered dog is required. If your dog does not have a TDAA registration number yet, please complete the Registration form, and submit fee with trial entry.

Entries close at 6 p.m. Friday, March 29, 2019 and cannot be cancelled, altered or substituted after that time. Entries received after 6 p.m. Friday, March 29, 2019 will be considered as Day of Show entries and subject to the higher Day of Show fees.

Volunteers

Signups for volunteers will be done at the time of the trial.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper measured height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered at any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a higher height division from their measured height will be scored in the higher height division. Dogs that run at a lower height than their measured height will be scored with dogs of their measured height. Special provisions for Jump Height Exemptions that are based on a dog's structure are explained in detail at <http://www.k9tdaa.com>. Click on rules and go to section 3.5 Jump Heights.

- 2" – restricted to dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less at the withers.
- 4" – restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less at the withers.
- 8" – restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less at the withers.
- 12" - restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less at the withers.
- 16" - open to all dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Class Information

Standard class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Game Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

A copy of your TDAA height card must accompany your trial application or be presented at check-in. If you do not have a TDAA height card your dog must be measured.

If this is your first time entering a TDAA trial and you have not received a TDAA number, please write "pending" on the entry form in place of the TDAA number.

SIGNING UP

If your dog does not have a TDAA number, the Dog Registration Form is on the last page of this premium list.

You may still enter our trial weekend; simply put "Pending" on the entry form and include a copy of this Registration form with your entry, along with the additional \$12.00 fee.
