AWARDS: Ribbons will be available for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. There will be a prize for each dog entered in the trial.

FEO (For Exhibition Only): These runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class at any level. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food are allowed in the ring. The team will get a maximum of 1.5 times the Standard Course Time for their FEO run.

DISABLED HANDLERS: A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course time for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

Standard classes will run: Superior, Intermediate, Beginner.

Games classes will run: Games III, Games II, Games I.

Saturday running order: Tall to small. Sunday running order: Small to tall.

Friday Run-Thru

FRIDAY, APRIL 26th, KCTC will offer Teacup run-thru from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM.

Pre-registration is not required.

Cost: \$5.00 per run or \$12 for unlimited runs.

Saturday Games Classes

Pinball Wizard

The goal is to accumulate as many points as possible within course time: 50 seconds for big dogs and 55 seconds for small dogs. The start obstacle is the dogwalk; in either direction. After successfully completing the start obstacle, the team continues to accumulate points by completing obstacles of the handler's/dog's choosing. All scoring obstacles may be completed twice for points; triggers and bonuses can be taken many times. No obstacle may be taken back-to-back. The table is always live. If the dog touches the table it is a tilt and play ends.

Once the start obstacle has been completed, the triggers become active. Triggers open the bonus obstacles allowing the dog to triple all points earned. The bonus is the two tunnels marked bonus, in any order and any direction.

The bonus may be earned three times during play. The successful completion of the bonus triples all points accumulated each time it is completed.

To reactivate the triggers after completing the bonus, at least one point must be earned. A whistle sounds at the end of point accumulation. The dog should be directed to the table to stop time.

If a fault is called, point accumulation continues, but the triggers becomes dormant. The dog must do the dogwalk/start again to reactivate the triggers. Faults include the usual performance faults like: knocked bar, missed contact, starting the weave poles without completing.

Black Hole

The course is divided into 3 loops: the "inner" loop, the "in-and-out" loop, and the "outer" loop.

If a fault occurs during a loop, the dog must immediately restart from the first obstacle of that loop. The loop is repeated until completed without fault. Then the dog starts the next loop. The judge will call out "fault" when a dog faults an obstacle. Standard faults apply: refusals are not faulted.

Sunday Games Classes

Beat the Clock

Beat the Clock is a sequencing game in which the obstacles are arranged in four parts, like quadrants of the clock. Obstacles are typically arranged around the tire. The handler is required to do the tire before each of the quadrants. Beat the Clock is scored Points, Then Time.

Rodeo

Rodeo is a three-part game consisting of events held in a rodeo: Barrel racing using tunnels, pole bending using the weaves, and bronco riding which is a short Jumpers course. Rodeo is scored Points, Less Faults with time as a tie breaker.

Disclaimer: Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings.

ELIGIBILITY: This trial is open to all dogs 17" and under at the withers and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness, which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs do not have to be registered with TDAA before the trial. Dogs can register for TDAA on the day of trial. These dogs will have pending numbers until their TDAA number is issued.

All contact equipment is rubberized.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Snacks and drinks will be available at the trial. Lunch will be available on site for Saturday and Sunday.

There will be a dog potty area provided. Please pick up after your dog. Plastic bags and garbage receptacles will be provided.

Moving up to the next class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing or by email, no later than Monday, April 17, 2019 at 6:00pm. Move ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the beginning of the higher class.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, the dog can move up from Game I to Games III by earning qualifying scores in each of the lower two levels.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.**

Submit \$8.00 with a class move-up request and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This payment must be paid even if it was paid for an earlier trial.

ENTRIES: Entries open on April 1st, 2019. There is no closing date. Day of trial entries will be accepted.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Make checks payable to: Keystone Canine Training Club. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, weather, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial or in the building. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.

Class Information

STANDARD CLASS:

BEGINNER AGILITY— All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agility Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES CLASS:

GAMES I— All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height. Dogs without a TDAA height card will need to be measured at the trial.

- 4" jump height - Restricted to dogs measuring 8 inches and under at the withers
- 8" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 12 inches and under at the withers
- 12" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 15 inches and under at the withers
- 16" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 17 inches or less at the withers.

Do not enter "Keystone Canine Training Club." Otherwise, the directions will be wrong!

From Downtown Pittsburgh: Take Liberty Bridge through the Liberty Tunnel, staying in the right lane. Turn right AFTER the light at the end of the tunnel onto the cloverleaf for Rt. 51 South. Turn right onto Streets Run Rd. Go to the T-intersection and turn left at the light onto Brownsville Rd. KCTC is on the left, just after Option Supply.

From I-79: Take I-79 to Exit 55. Turn right at the light at the end of the exit ramp onto Rt. 50 and get into the left lane. Turn left at the first light onto Vanadium Rd. Turn left at first light onto Bower Hill Rd. Turn right at the first light onto Kelso Rd. Go to the dead end and turn left at the T-intersection onto Painters Run Rd. It will change name to Conner Rd. Take it to the end at Rt. 88 (Library Rd.). Turn right onto Rt. 88, then turn left onto Broughton Road (Walgreens on the right corner). Go to the T-intersection and turn left at the light. Then go under the bridge and turn left onto Brownsville Rd. KCTC will be on your right just before Option Supply.

From the East: Take the Parkway East (I-376) to the Boulevard of the Allies to the Liberty Bridge and go thru the Liberty Tunnel, staying in the right lane. Turn right AFTER the light at the end of the tunnel onto the cloverleaf for Rt. 51 South. Turn right onto Streets Run Rd. Go to the T-intersection and turn left at the light onto Brownsville Rd. KCTC is on the left, just after Option Supply.

Alternate Directions from the Far East to Avoid Downtown Pittsburgh

Traffic: Take I-70 West to Route 51 North. Go 18 miles and take the 2nd cloverleaf exit at the top of a long hill (just past the U-Haul rental on the right) onto Curry Hollow Road west-bound (follow the "Yellow Belt./Bethel Park/South Park" sign). Go past the Sunoco station on the right, then down a long hill, and turn right onto Brownsville Road just before the overhead railroad bridge.. KCTC will be about 0.8 miles on the right, just before Option Supply.

From the South Hills or Finleyville or Library: Take South Park Road or Route 88 North to the 5-way intersection (GetGo on the far corner). Take a right onto South Park Road (if coming from Route 88). (Note - South Park Road becomes Baptist Road.) Take the 2nd right onto Broughton Rd. Go to the T-intersection and turn left at the light. Then go under the railroad bridge and turn left at a light onto Brownsville Rd. KCTC will be 0.8 miles on your right just before Option Supply.

From South Park: Take Brownsville Road. Go under a railroad bridge, then turn left at the first light to stay on Brownsville. Go about 0.8 miles and KCTC is on the right, just past the Loose Moose Tavern.

From Elizabeth or Pleasant Hills: Take Route 51 North. Exit at the cloverleaf just past the U-Haul dealer and follow the signs that say "Yellow Belt/South Park/Bethel Park" and turn right onto Lebanon Church Road. Go past the Sunoco station on the right, then down a long hill, and turn right onto Brownsville Road just before the overhead railroad bridge.. KCTC will be about 0.8 miles on the right, just before Option Supply.

Motels: Hotels/Motels that will accept dogs. Please make sure that your pick up after your dogs so that these hotels will continue to accept dogs. Check with hotel when making reservations—acceptance of dogs is subject to change.
