## TRIAL INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors on rubber over padding. The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. 2" jumps will be obtained by crossing bars on the 4" jump cups.

A-frame (6' 8" slatless)	Tire Jump (16")	Dog walk (8' slatless ramps)	Table (30" by 30")
Open (Pipe)Tunnel (16")	Single & winged jumps	Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide)	Weave poles (22" centers)

Warm up on TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.

**Awards:** Ribbons awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

**PLEASE PICK UP POOP AT THE SHOW SITE/HOTELS. All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.**

**Eligibility:** This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

**Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.** There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)

## STANDARD COURSE BETA FORMAT – ALSO KNOWN AS DOUBLE RUN

Beta format is for pairs of Standard runs (1 & 2, 3 & 4, and so on) and allows you to run the same course twice in the same course order (no renumbering of obstacles, no changing the course). And yes, you can qualify twice too!

**There is no 2<sup>nd</sup> walk-thru before round 2**, so if you're only running round 2 you walk before round 1. **There are no move-ups in between each beta round** (i.e. you can't move up in Std 1 and run the next level in Std 2.)

A pair of double run/beta standards would run like this: Set Std1/Std 2 course for Beginner; walk course, run Std 1, then immediately Std 2. Reset course for Std 1/Std 2 Intermediate; walk, run Std 1, run Std 2; Reset course for Superior.

## GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

*Call or email if you have any questions about these games!*

**Rock, Paper, Scissors** is based on the traditional game of hand signals with the same name. The handler will play rock, paper, scissors with another person to determine which of three nested, numbered courses to run. No weaves. Scored Time + Faults. Note: All levels will run together, but all rocks will run together, all scissors together, and all paper together.

**Call, Direct & Send** is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call (lead out), Direct (distance challenge approximately mid-course), and Send to finish line. Scored Time+Faults-Bonuses. Note: All levels run together.

**Connect the Dots** is a dog's choice point accumulation game. The objective is to handle the dog from dot to dot (the contact obstacles) scoring points on all other obstacles in between. Points for the "in between" obstacles are always at risk; they can be lost in the event of any fault since the last "dot" was completed. Scored Points, Then Time. Note: All levels will run together.

**Dealer's Choice** is a course to be completed by the numbers. However, the course contains options; the same number may appear on more than one obstacle. It is the handler's choice or the dog's choice as to which path to take. Scored Time+Faults. Note: All levels will run together.

**Mute Agility** is a game of agility where the handler is silent. This will be a numbered course without weaves. A verbal release will be allowed at any time on course. One additional word will be allowed without fault but not the dog's name nor an obstacle name. Choose wisely, the word can only be used once! Faults will be assigned for other verbal commands, whistles, claps, stomps... Scored Time+Faults. Note: All levels will run together.

**Power & Speed** is a two part game. In the first part [Power] the dog will run an un-timed sequence of mostly technical obstacles (contacts and possibly weaves). In the second part [Speed] the dog will run a timed jumpers course. Scored Time+Faults. Note: All levels will run together.

**Stars & Stripes Forever** is a mystery game themed for Memorial Day. It is a numbered course with no weaves for G1. Scored Time+Faults. Note: All levels will run together.

**Sinking Ship** is a dog's choice game where you are the telegraph operator on a sinking ship. It is up to you and your dog to transmit the internationally recognized distress signal, "SOS" or three dots, three dashes and three dots. You must transmit this exact signal, then grab your life preserver (dog goes through the tire), and get to the lifeboats (finish line). Scored Points>Qualifying Points, Then Time. Note: All levels will run together.

	<b>Superior</b>	Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible.
<b>Games Classes</b>	<b>Games I</b>	All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
	<b>Games II</b>	Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible.
	<b>Games III</b>	Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible.

## PETIT PRIX TOURNAMENT RULES & DESCRIPTIONS

Qualifying rounds for the Petit Prix Tournament are being held at this event. The Tournament Rules may be downloaded on the Internet at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com), and are hereby incorporated by reference. All dogs registered with the TDAA are eligible to enter the Qualifying round, without regard to level of competition. The Qualifying round will be judged under Superior rules for performance, using Superior rates of travel. Body type and veterans height exemptions shall be scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. **Exemptions for "Self-declared" heights will not be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament.**

PLEASE NOTE: Qualifications earned in these qualifying events are recorded for titling at the level for which the dog is eligible.

**FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes:** TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

**Fast Track Move-Ups:** Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

See [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com) for updates to Rules and height divisions!

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper measured height division.** Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a higher height division from their measured height will be scored in the higher height division. Dogs that run at a lower height than their measured height will be scored with dogs of their measured height.

**TDAA Height Divisions:** **Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter.**

- **2" jump height:** for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers (or with body type or veterans exemptions)
- **4" jump height:** for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers;
- **8" jump height:** for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers;
- **12" jump height:** for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers;
- **16" jump height:** for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

**Dogs may qualify for a body type exemption** permitting them to jump at a lower height. These include long back, weight/height (not related to obesity), and deep chest/dwarfish legs.

**All dogs without a permanent height card must be measured** first thing in the morning on the first day of competing at this trial. Please arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

### **Veteran Dogs and Disabled Handlers:**

- Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) receive an extension of standard course time, and can jump one height lower
- Disabled Handlers receive an extension of 4 seconds to standard course times and qualifying course times for games. Proof of disability shall be the handler's disabled parking tag or other documentation.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- \* Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

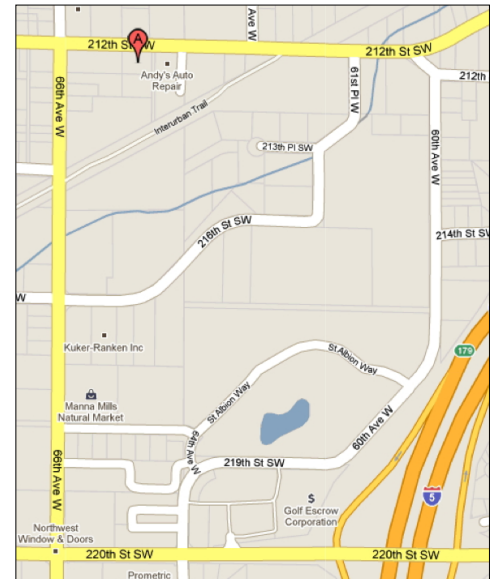
