TRIAL INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors on rubber over padding. The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. 2" jumps will be obtained by crossing bars on the 4" jump cups.

<i>A-frame (6' 8" slatless)</i>	<i>Tire Jump (16")</i>	<i>Dog walk (8' slatless ramps)</i>	<i>Table (30" by 30")</i>
<i>Open (Pipe) Tunnel (16")</i>	<i>Single & winged jumps</i>	<i>Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide)</i>	<i>Weave poles (22" centers)</i>

A warm up area with TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS

All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online at www.k9tdaa.com

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

Call or email if you have any questions about these games!

Full House is a dog's choice game, requiring accumulation of required points within the time allowed. Points are gathered as three-of-a-kind, a pair, and a joker as defined on the course map.

Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The first is dog's-choice in which the dog earns the right to score three "colored" obstacles by doing a red hurdle before each. The second part is a simple sequence. Snooker is scored Points, then Time.

Wildcard is run like any standard agility course. However, Wildcard is different from in one important way. At three designated points on the course the handler will have a choice of which "Wildcards" (two obstacles placed approximately parallel to each other) to perform for that number in the sequence.

Jackpot is a two-part game. The first part consists of the dog working to accumulate at least the minimum required points for their level. In the second part the dog must be directed to attempt a distance challenge earning points for each successfully completed. Jackpot is scored Points, then Time.

Colors Successfully run your choice of one of the two over-lapping mini-agility courses on the same field.

Jumpers is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Agility Class

Beginner All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Intermediate Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games II Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games III Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

PETIT PRIX TOURNAMENT RULES & DESCRIPTIONS

Qualifying rounds for the Petit Prix Tournament are being held at this event. The Tournament Rules may be downloaded on the Internet at www.k9tdaa.com, and are hereby incorporated by reference. All dogs registered with the TDAA are eligible to enter the Qualifying round, without regard to level of competition. The Qualifying round will be judged under Superior rules for performance, using Superior rates of travel. Body type and veterans height exemptions shall be scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. Exemptions for "Self-declared" heights will not be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament.

PLEASE NOTE: Qualifications earned in these qualifying events are recorded for titling at the level for which the dog is eligible. PP qualifying runs will be run at the end of the day.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes

TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

NEW RULES REGARDING USE OF FOOD IN THE RING

As of January 1, 2019, TDAA has issued new rules regarding the use of food in the ring:

5.2.2.11 Use of Food Treats

The handler shall be allowed to carry and use food treats in the ring as reward for the dog so long as the food treat is not offered in a way that assists the dog in course direction or in the performance of an obstacle.

The dog is faulted when the handler uses a food treat in a manner that assists the dog in course direction (standard fault) or in the performance of an obstacle (failure to perform). A food treat must be kept secure by the handler. The dog shall earn a standard fault if the handler carries food in hand while the dog is working or at any time drops a food treat on the floor or equipment.

Questions regarding this rule change will be addressed during the General Briefing each day of the trial.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper measured height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a higher height division from their measured height will be scored in the higher height division. Dogs that run at a self-selected lower height than their measured height will be scored with dogs of their measured height.

Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter.

Dogs may qualify for a body type exemption, such as long back, weight/height (not related to obesity), deep chest/dwarfish legs.

All dogs without a permanent height card must be measured first thing in the morning on the first day of competing at this trial. Please arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) and Disabled Handlers may receive additional time as outlined in section 5.3.2.1 of the rules.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Full refund for bitches in heat if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than the Friday before the trial.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. We need all hands to make a trial work. **Please sign up on the volunteer board at the trial to work during classes you are not running in.** We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through. We'll make sure you are instructed on how to do a job, and it's actually fun and you learn a lot getting a different view of the trial and different handlers!

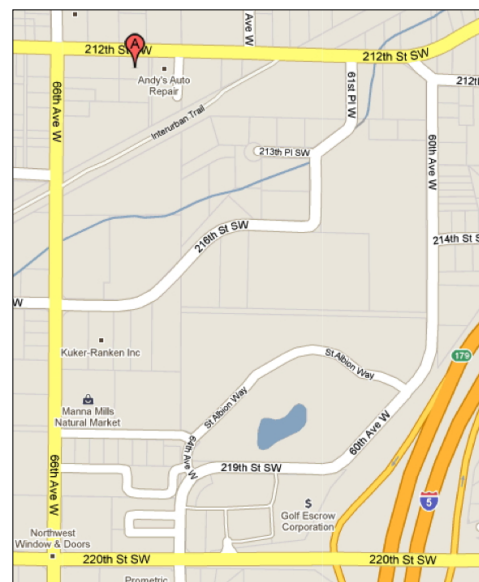
