### **Eligibility**

This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com.

A warm up area, consisting of regulation TDAA equipment, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

**Obstacle Familiarization** will be provided on Saturday and Sunday mornings 15 minutes prior to judging for all dogs and handlers. **No toys or treats may be used in the ring during familiarization.** 

#### **Awards**

Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Fast track dogs will only get qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels. One High in Trial will be offered each day to one dog/handler team that competes in all classes per day. HIT to be determined by highest combined scores, then fastest combined time if score is tied.

### Move-Ups

Pre-entry move-ups requests must be in writing but may be sent via email to the trial secretary at <a href="LKO1014@yahoo.com">LKO1014@yahoo.com</a> at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

### **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers (or with body type or veterans exemptions)
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers;
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers;
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers;
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

**ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD** must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENT BY TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in the TDAA without requiring measurement.

**Disabled Handlers:** A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

#### **Fast Track Program**

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score but no higher than the comparable level. You must submit a copy of certificates from the organization in which the higher level title was earned for each dog.

A dog eligible for Fast Tracking may only move up one class at a time and not skip over a class whether or not they met the criteria for a higher class in the first test. A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he received the qualifying score and will not earn a title or receive a title certificate for that level.

Please mark the classes that apply on the Trial Entry form and submit an additional \$8.00 with your entry (payable to DTCT). Payment of this fee is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. The Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for a previous trial.

All obstacles meet the TDAA equipment size requirements.

#### **Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, e.g., the warm-up area and the designated off leash area.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9TDAA.com.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dog will be subject to dismissal with no refund of their entry fees.

No dogs shall be left at the trial site overnight.

TDAA and the Dog Training Club of Tampa are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or unprescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the building the day of a TDAA event.





#### **Directions to the Trial Site**

From the North – Take I75 South and get on I275 where it splits just south of the Exit at Hwy 56.

Continue on 1275 to the Hillsborough Avenue Exit. Make a right (West) onto Hillsborough Avenue (US 92).

Follow Hillsborough to Lois (about a 1/4 of a mile west of the Dale Mabry overpass).

Make a left at the light onto N. Lois.

The club is two blocks south on the left at 4817 N. Lois.

From the West/South – Take 275 North to Dale Mabry East (North Bound).

Going North on Dale Mabry make a left (West) onto Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd which is just after the stadium.

Make a right onto Lois.

The club will be on the right in a couple blocks or so.

From the East – Take I 4 to I 275 to Dale Mabry East (Northbound).

Going North on Dale Mabry make a left (West) onto Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd which is just after the stadium.

Make a right onto Lois.

The club will be on the right in a couple blocks or so.

RV Parking – There is NO room for RVs at the trial site. Overnight parking at the trial site is NOT allowed.

### Class Information Standard Classes

**Beginner** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from another organization.

**Intermediate** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### **Games Classes**

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**FEO (For Exhibition Only)** – FEO runs are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO participants cannot repeat any obstacles; no training is permitted in the ring.

### **Games Class Descriptions**

The following are some brief descriptions of the games offered at this trial. We encourage you to enter the games classes even if they seem unfamiliar to you – we are sure that you will have lots of fun!

Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will provide a thorough briefing to exhibitors and hard copies of the complete rules and qualifying requirements will be available. Example briefings are available on TDAA's Web site at www.k9tdaa.com.

**Run 'Til You Drop** challenges the handler to correctly estimate the dog's working speed, accumulating as many points as possible within the allotted time. Scoring and time ends on the teeter as the last obstacle (the drop!) doubling the dog's score only if time has not expired. Run 'Til You Drop is scored Points, Then Time.

**Cha-Cha** is a game that requires the dog to earn points to the beat of the Cha-cha: two slow beats (non-jump obstacles) followed by three quick beats (jumps). This is a game of strategy and precision.

**Wildcard** is run like a standard agility course. The dog is required to perform a sequence designated by the judge. However, Wildcard is different from standard agility in one important way. At three designated points on the course the handler, or possibly the dog, will have a choice of which obstacle, out of three obstacles, to perform for that number in the sequence. This is called a Wildcard. The dog must take one of each number (a 1, a 2 and a 3), in the order of his choice, from the three Wildcards on the course. Repeating a number already taken from an earlier Wildcard will be ruled an off course.

**Twister** is a fast moving point accumulation game with multiple and rapid changes of direction on a circular course consisting of inner and outer tracks made up of tunnels and jumps. The course is not numbered. The handler and dog must start at a specified start line but may choose in which direction to go to complete the first 5 obstacles on the outer track. The judge shall count out loud the completed obstacles. After successfully completing 5 obstacles, the team must turn and take 4 obstacles going in the other direction on the other inside track. At the whistle, dog must cross the finish line to stop time.

Octagon Game - Starting with the 12 o'clock jump, dog and handler must perform all jumps in a serpentine fashion in the direction designated by the judge (either clockwise or counterclockwise). If the dog knocks a bar, crosses the line of poles in the center of the octagon, or refuses a jump, the dog must perform the weave poles. The correct weave pole entry is the entry closest to the point of the mistake. The Octagon Game is scored time only. The judge will whistle for any fault to indicate that the dog must go to the center of the octagon to perform the weave poles. There is no fault for an improper entry or a missed pole, but the handler must redirect the dog to fix a missed entry or a missed pole.

All pre-entries must be postmarked by 6:00 p.m., May 27, 2017. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), postmarked by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to the Dog Training Club of Tampa (DTCT).

You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

Entries will not be accepted without fees. **No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery.** All entries must be submitted on an official TDAA Agility Entry Form, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA Agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.

All fees must be paid in U.S. funds. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before June 2, 2017.
