**PETIT PRIX TOURNAMENT RULES & DESCRIPTIONS**

**Petit Prix Qualifier** Tournament Rules are at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com) , and are hereby incorporated by reference. All dogs registered with the TDAA are eligible to enter the Qualifying round, without regard to level of competition. The Qualifying round will be judged under Superior rules for performance, using Superior rates of travel. Body type and veterans height exemptions are scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. Exemptions for "Self-declared" heights **will not be recognized** for play in the Petit Prix tournament. NOTE: Qualifications earned in these qualifying events are recorded for titling at the level for which the dog is eligible.

A warm up area with TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization available both mornings prior to judging.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

**Move-ups:** allowed from day-to-day. Contact the trial secretary by the end of Saturday for Sunday changes.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS  
All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.

**Eligibility:** This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

**CLASS INFORMATION**

**Standard Agility Class**

- Beginner** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Intermediate** Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Superior** Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games Classes**

- Games I** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Games II** Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Games III** Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Fast Track Move-Ups:** Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move-up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move-up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move-up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move-up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00** with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS - See [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com) for to Rules and height divisions!**

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.**

- 4" measured height ~ dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" measured height ~ dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" measured height ~ dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" measured height – dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers

**No More jump height exemptions:** The TDAA will allow a dog's handler/owner to choose what jump height is appropriate for that dog. Dogs will place with dogs in the height class in which they measure at the withers. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. A dog's jump height may be changed, at the trial, only with the permission of the trial secretary.

**TDAA no longer observes a four-paw safety rule on contacts in the Beginner Standard class** (or in any game using Beginner rules for performance). The Beginner dog will **have three chances to perform** a contact obstacle, and are not faulted until a third on-and-off refusal.

**If you do not have a TDAA height card or email your dog must be measured at this trial.**

**Disabled Handlers** – A time exemption of 4 seconds is granted to disabled handlers for Standard course times and for qualifying course times for games class. The proof of the disability shall be the handler's disability parking tag or other documentation. There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

**FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes \$8 per run** – FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT.

#### **5.2.2.11 Use of Food Treats** (January 1, 2019, TDAA has issued new rules regarding the use of food in the ring)

*The handler shall be allowed to carry and use food treats in the ring as reward for the dog so long as the food treat is not offered in a way that assists the dog in course direction or in the performance of an obstacle. The dog is faulted when the handler uses a food treat in a manner that assists the dog in course direction (standard fault) or in the performance of an obstacle (failure to perform). A food treat must be kept secure by the handler. The dog shall earn a standard fault if the handler carries food in hand while the dog is working or at any time drops a food treat on the floor or equipment.*

**Questions regarding this rule change will be addressed during the General Briefing each day of the trial.**

### **GAMES DESCRIPTIONS**

**Truth or Dare** is a fun game in which the handler has the option to either run a course as a standard numbered course; or earn points for obstacles by performing them in the order and direction of his choosing. *Truth or Dare* is scored points, then time.

**Rabbit Express** is a numbered course that features compelling wrong course options called "Rabbit Holes" if the dog falls into one of these he is not faulted, but must run a short "detour" sequence. *Rabbit Express* is scored time, plus faults.

**The Tunnel-Crossover Game** is a follow-the-numbers game with a touch of distance work. Four tunnels creating a crossover effect create a zone through which the handler is not allowed to move. Consequently, the handler must work the course from outside the crossover arrangement. *The Tunnel-Crossover Game* is scored Time Only.

**Tag 10** is a dog's choice game in which the dog and handler are challenged to collect points in 10 point blocks. Faulting any obstacle erases unbanked points! *Tag 10* is scored points, then time.

**Power and Speed** is a two-part game. In the first part [Power] the dog will run an un-timed sequence of mostly technical obstacles; and in the second part [Speed] the dog will run a timed jumpers course. *Power and Speed* is scored time, plus faults.

**Lucky 13** is a dog's choice game in which obstacles are laid out on the field valued from 1 point to 20 points. The dog may do only 13, without repeating any, earning the value of the assigned numbers as he works. *Lucky 13* is scored points, less faults, then time.

### **DIRECTIONS to SchaSam Farm 4910 268<sup>th</sup> St NW Stanwood WA 98292**

- From 1-5, take **exit #121** Stanwood-Camano Island exit.
- Go **west** toward Stanwood/Camano.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and **that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.**
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made.**
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season not permitted in the trial. Full refund for bitches in heat, if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than July 3, 2019.
