## **Notice to Exhibitors**

---

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Chair, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Water proof mats must be under all crates.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all registered TDAA dogs who measure 17" or less and are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

**ENTRIES CLOSE** 6:00 p.m., July 10, 2019.

**GATE/BUILDING OPENS AT 7:30am for set-up. Do not plan to arrive before that time.**

**There will be no Friday night Set-up. There is plenty of crate space so don't worry!**

The order of classes may be changed at the discretion of the Trial Host and the judge. Please be alert for announcements during the trial.

**Full House:** *Full House* is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. *Full House* is scored Points, Less Penalty, Then Time.

**Colors:** *Colors* is made up of two relatively equal sequences. The handler must select one and, prior to running, announce to the judge which course they intend to complete.

**FAST:** The objective is to perform all or as many of the obstacles as possible so long as time allows. Somewhere in the course the dog will have a Send Bonus which will allow the dog to earn 20 bonus points. The successful completion of this Send Bonus is required for the dog to qualify in the class.

**Dare to Double:** Dare to Double is a simple dog's choice game, the dog will earn points for taking obstacles in the order and direction of the handler's choosing. The team has 50 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. The A Frame has a special value. It is the doubling obstacle. During the run, a handler may double his current points by performing the doubling obstacle. A successful performance doubles all points earned up to that time. If the dog faults the A Frame half the existing points are lost. A team may double points any time and as many times as they wish.

## Class Information

---

### Standard Class

**BEGINNER AGILITY**—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see rules for fast track titling.)

**INTERMEDIATE AGILITY** — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**SUPERIOR AGILITY** — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

### Games Class

**GAMES I**—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see rules for fast track titling.)

**GAMES II** — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**GAMES III** — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

### Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper height division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 2" for dogs 4" and under at the withers; dogs 8" or less with an exemption
- 4" for dogs 8" and under at the withers; dogs 12" or less with an exemption
- 8" for dogs 12" and under at the withers; dogs 16" or less with an exemption
- 12" for dogs 16" and under at the withers; dogs 17" or less with an exemption
- 16" for dogs 17" or less at the withers.

### How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

Submit \$8.00 with your move-up request, and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have four chances at each), and is non-refundable.

## Entries

Entries close at 6:00 pm on July 10, 2019, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Day of Show entries will be accepted until 8:00am each day with an additional fee.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are *not* acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are *not* acceptable. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Chair.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial or on the trial grounds. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason or for injured dogs. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

**WARM-UPS:** A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class of the day.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.
