Covid 19

We will adhere to all local, state and federal guidelines in regards to number of participants allowed, and social distancing practices in place at the time of the trial. Specifically contingent upon Snohomish County being in Phase 3 of the Washington State Reopening Plan which allows for gatherings of 5-50 people. The trial committee will decide to cancel by July 1 (full refunds). If you are ill, **please stay home**. If we deem an exhibitor ill at the event, we have the option to excuse that exhibitor. Make sure your dog is ok with people wearing masks. We don't want a dog becoming fearful due to something they've never seen before.

A hand washing station with soap will be available at the pump house in close vicinity to the ring. Towels are **NOT** provided so bring your own drying implement. Please bring your own sanitizer if you prefer that method. The porta-potty has hand sanitizer taped to the outside. Please let the trial committee know if supplies run low.

A warm up area with TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization available both mornings prior to judging.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

Move-ups: allowed from day-to-day. Contact the trial secretary by the end of Saturday for Sunday changes.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS
All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. You can register at the trial, complete the attached form or download an application at www.k9tdaa.com Registered dogs do **NOT** need to complete another form.

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CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Agility Class

Beginner All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move-up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move-up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move-up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move-up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00** with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS - See www.k9tdaa.com for to Rules and height divisions!

No More jump height exemptions: The TDAA will allow a dog's handler/owner to choose what jump height is appropriate for that dog. Dogs will place with dogs in the height class in which they measure at the withers. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. A dog's jump height may be changed, at the trial, only with the permission of the trial secretary.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

- 4" measured height ~ dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" measured height ~ dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" measured height ~ dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" measured height – dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers

TDAA no longer observes a four-paw safety rule on contacts in the Beginner Standard class (or in any game using Beginner rules for performance). The Beginner dog will **have three chances to perform** a contact obstacle, and are not faulted until a third on-and-off refusal.

If you do not have a TDAA height card or email your dog must be measured at this trial.

Disabled Handlers – A time exemption of 4 seconds is granted to disabled handlers for Standard course times and for qualifying course times for games class. The proof of the disability shall be the handler's disability parking tag or other documentation. There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes \$8 per run – FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT.

5.2.2.11 Use of Food Treats (January 1, 2019, TDAA issued rules regarding the use of food in the ring)

The handler shall be allowed to carry and use food treats in the ring as reward for the dog so long as the food treat is not offered in a way that assists the dog in course direction or in the performance of an obstacle. The dog is faulted when the handler uses a food treat in a manner that assists the dog in course direction (standard fault) or in the performance of an obstacle (failure to perform). A food treat must be kept secure by the handler. The dog shall earn a standard fault if the handler carries food in hand while the dog is working or at any time drops a food treat on the floor or equipment.

Questions regarding this rule change will be addressed during the General Briefing each day of the trial.

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

Heinz 57 is a strategic dog's choice point accumulation game. The purpose of the game is to score exactly 57 points using a doubling obstacle (the tire). Handler's Choice is scored points only. ER11

Connect the Dots is a dog's choice point accumulation game. The objective is to handle the dog from dot to dot (the contact obstacles) scoring points on all other obstacles in between. Points for the "in between" obstacles are always at risk, as they'll be lost in case of any fault since the last "dot". Connect the Dots is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Beat the Clock is a sequencing game in which the obstacles are arranged in four parts, like quadrants of the clock. Obstacles are typically arranged around the tire. The handler is required to do the tire before each of the quadrants. Beat the Clock is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Call, Direct and Send (CDS) is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonuses. ER7

Just In Time is a dog's-choice point accumulation game in which the dog earns special bonuses for ending in a timely manner. Just in Time is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

The Box game is a sequencing game, typically using only jumps and tunnels, providing for bonuses for the dog working at a distance. The Box Game is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonuses. ER7

DIRECTIONS to SchaSam Farm 4910 268th St NW Stanwood WA 98292

- From 1-5, take **exit #121** Stanwood-Camano Island exit. Go **west** toward Stanwood/Camano.
- Just after the first traffic light (between the two gas stations), **turn right** onto 12th Avenue NW.
- Then take an immediate **left** onto 268th Street NW. Travel on 268th for **2 miles**.
- You will see an orange mailbox for 4910 on your right but you will **turn left** into the driveway below orange streamers and immediately **turn right** through the double wire gates **into the field**.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and **that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.**
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made.**
- Toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season not permitted in the trial. Full refund for bitches in heat, if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than July 15, 2020.
