TRIAL INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors on rubber over padding. The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. 2" jumps will be obtained by crossing bars on the 4" jump cups.

Certification *Permission has been granted by the Teacup Dogs Agility Association for the holding of this event under Teacup Dog Agility Association Rules and Regulations.*

A-frame (6' 8" slatless) Tire Jump (16") Dog walk (8' slatless ramps) Table (30" by 30")
Open (Pipe) Tunnel (16") Single & winged jumps Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide) Weave poles (22" centers)

A warm up area with TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS
All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online at www.k9tdaa.com

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS *Call or email if you have any questions about these games!*

Four Leaf Clover is a game in which obstacles are arranged in a pattern resembling a four-leaf clover. The dog earns bonuses for performing the leaves of the clover while the handler stays in the middle. Four Leaf Clover is scored Points, Then Time.

Jumpers is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up.

Just in Time is a "dog's-choice" game in which the dog earns special bonuses for ending in a timely manner. Just in Time is scored Points, Then Time.

Miniature Golf is an agility game that is played like a game of golf. The handler tees his dog into one of three tunnels closely grouped together and then runs a short course associated with the tunnel the dog chooses. *Miniature Golf* is scored Time, plus Faults, less Bonus.

Jackpot is a two-part game: dog's choice point accumulation followed by a distance challenge. The objective is for the dog-and-handler team to accumulate as many points as possible in the allotted time and to successfully complete the distance challenge. Jackpot is scored points then time.

Fullhouse is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Full House is scored Points, Then Time.

Colors is a sequencing game. The handler has a choice of running either short course that are woven together on the field.

Wildcard is run like any standard agility course. However, Wildcard is different from standard agility in one important way. At three designated points on the course the handler, or possibly the dog, will have a choice of which of two obstacle to perform for that number in the sequence. This is called a Wildcard.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Agility Class

Beginner All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Intermediate Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games II Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games III Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes

TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

See www.k9tdaa.com for updates to Rules and height divisions!

Owners are responsible for entering the proper measured height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a higher height division from their measured height will be scored in the higher height division. Dogs that run at a lower height than their measured height will be scored with dogs of their measured height.

TDAA Height Divisions: **Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter.**

- **2" jump height:** for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers (or with body type or veterans exemptions)
- **4" jump height:** for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers;
- **8" jump height:** for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers;
- **12" jump height:** for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers;
- **16" jump height:** for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Dogs may qualify for a body type exemption permitting them to jump at a lower height. These include long back, weight/height (not related to obesity), and deep chest/dwarfish legs.

All dogs without a permanent height card must be measured first thing in the morning on the first day of competing at this trial. Please arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

Veteran Dogs and Disabled Handlers:

- Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) receive an extension of standard course time, and can jump one height lower
 - Measured height of 2" & 4" dogs receive an additional 4 seconds
 - Measured heights of 8", 12" & 16" dogs receive an additional 2 seconds
- Disabled Handlers receive an extension of 4 seconds to standard course times and qualifying course times for games. Proof of disability shall be the handler's disabled parking tag or other documentation.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Full refund for bitches in heat if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than the Friday before the trial.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. We need all hands to make a trial work. **Please sign up on the volunteer board at the trial to work during classes you are not running in.** We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through.
