Trial Site and Region



Wadsworth, Ohio

If you are coming from I-71 - get off at the Rt. 18 exit, and go East. If you are coming from I-77 - get off at the Rt. 18 exit, and go West. Take Route 18 to Route 94 (Ridge Rd.) Go south on Route 94.

This will become Ridge Road, and later, Main Street

Travel south on Rt. 94, until you get to Wadsworth.
Go straight through town in Wadsworth, staying on Rt. 94.

Our building is on the left, about 2 blocks south of the old town square.
It is a big brick factory - the address is 251 Main St.
(Possibly the address is not displayed anywhere.)
The first street at the south end of the building is Pine St.
Turn left onto Pine, and go approximately 150 feet,
Turn left into a small gravel driveway, next to a gray house.
It is the first drive on the left.

Please park behind the building in the gravel lot (not the paved lot) and

look for our marked entrance.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all registered TDAA dogs 20 inches or under, over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

ENTRIES CLOSE 6:00 p.m., September 20, 2016. Day of show entries will be accepted with an additional handling fee of \$2.00 per class.

This trial will be held indoors.

Games Classes

What's My Line?- The objective of is to perform all of the obstacles on the field without repeating or omitting any, as quickly as possible.

The handler earns one point for each obstacle his dog performs successfully. Each obstacle has the same value, regardless of the difficulty of performance and regardless of the number assigned to the obstacle. If an obstacle is performed twice, the dog will lose a point for the performance.

FAST- The objective of the Fifteen And Send Time class (FAST) is to perform all or as many of the obstacles as possible so long as time allows, without repeating any; *except* for jumps (valued at one point) which may be repeated (though never back-to-back)—and no more than 6 points can be earned from one-point obstacles.

Boston Bowling- Boston Bowling consists of two short courses, each starting with a specific entry to one of two tunnels, set side by side in a "U" shape. The handler bowls with his dog by sending the dog ahead into a tunnel entrance. Each dog and handler team has two bowls. The handler may not step over the penalty line as he bowls his dog into one of the tunnel entrances.

Copycat – Copycat is a "dog's-choice" game. That means the handler can direct the dog through the performance of obstacles in the order and direction of his own choosing, or the dog's choosing, as the case may be. The dog may perform each obstacle only twice for points. Obstacles must be correctly performed to earn points. If the dog performs obstacles of the same value one after the other the dog will earn a fault for "copycatting".

Jumpers – Jumpers courses consist only of hurdles and tunnels, with some limitations between the different venues. The dog is required to run the course in the sequence indicated by the judge. Follow the numbers. And keep the bars up.

Judge's briefing on the day of trial supersedes any previous briefings.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

WARM-UPS: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class.

MOVE-UPS: Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

Class Information

Standard Class

BEGINNER AGILITY—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see rules for fast track titling.)

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see rules for fast track titling.)

GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground \div height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- **4" jump height** Restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less.
- **8" jump height** Restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.
- **12" jump height** Restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.
- **16" jump height** Restricted to dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Acceptable Obstacles

A-Frame (6' 8" with slats) Teeter (10 foot) Weave Poles Closed (*Collapsed*) Tunnel Table (30 x 30) Single and Winged Jumps Open (*Pipe*)Tunnel Tire Jump Dogwalk (24' overall)

Entries

Entries close at 6:00 pm on September 5, 2017, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are *not* acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are *not* acceptable. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.
