Certification

Permission has been granted by the Teacup Dogs Agility Association for the holding of this event under Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules and Regulations, which are available at the TDAA website www.k9tdaa.com.

What is a Serial Trial??

The serial format trial is simply a sequence of small trials spread over a several weeks or months. Each individual trial offers fewer runs than a weekend event but also allows for a quick day to play and be done. All runs are reported to TDAA and are eligible for titling.

You may enter any combination of runs – one run on one day, or all runs on all days. You can enter one day at a time, or all three days at once. Each day has a separate closing date. The closing date for each of the individual Friday trials is the Tuesday before. Day-of trial entries cannot be accepted, so be sure and get your entry in by the closing date.

COVID-19 Restrictions

COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and in some cases death and an inherent risk of exposure exists in any public place. By entering and attending these trials, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agree to hold harmless; the club, event secretary, facility, and any other exhibitor for any transmission of any disease including but not limited to the COVID-19 virus. If you enter this trial, you also agree to abide by all rules and regulations in place for this event. Please read all COVID rules included on page 7.

A SIGNED WAIVER MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES

IF YOU ARE ILL, COUGHING, SNEEZING, RUNNING A TEMPERATURE OR FEEL UNWELL, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or COVID-19 symptoms (including, but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, or high temperature), please **stay home** (see refund policy under COVID Rules).

We want all participants to be safe and we need your help and cooperation to make the trial as safe as possible for everyone. Masks are required inside the building at all times and social distancing will be observed as much as possible. Due to the pandemic restrictions, entries for each day are limited to a maximum of **10 handlers**. There is no limit on the number of dogs or runs entered.

Trial Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs, without regard to breed or pedigree, measuring 20" or less, who are at least 12 months of age. No dog may participate with apparent injuries, lameness or bandages. Blind dogs, bitches in season, and dogs that are aggressive may not compete.

Dogs with three legs or feet, either by amputation or birth defect, shall be able to compete so long as the disability doesn't clearly create a safety hazard for the dog.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to compete in TDAA trials. There is a registration form included in the premium. You can register online at www.k9tdaa.com, mail a completed registration form to TDAA, or bring the form to the trial secretary for day-of-trial registration. If you have sent a registration form for your dog to TDAA but their number has not been received, please mark PENDING in the TDAA number space on the entry form.

Class Information

Standard Agility Class

- Beginner** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Intermediate** Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Superior** Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or the Teacup Superior Agility Dog (TSAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

- Games I** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Games II** Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Games III** Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Titling Ribbons will also be awarded to dogs completing a title. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast-Track dogs are not eligible for placement awards in classes through which they Fast Track.

Move-Ups

Move ups will be accepted between individual days of the serial trial. Day-of-trial move ups will not be accepted.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.



Standard Course BETA (double run) Format

Beta format is for pairs of Standard runs (1 & 2, 3 & 4, and so on) and allows you to run the same course twice in the same course order (no renumbering of obstacles, no changing the course). And yes, you can qualify twice too!

There is no 2nd walk-thru before round 2, so if you're only running round 2, you walk before round 1. There are no move-ups between each beta round (i.e. you can't move up in Standard 1 and run the next level in Standard 2.)

A pair of double run/beta standards would run like this: Set Standard1/Standard 2 course for Superior; walk course, run Standard 1, then immediately run Standard 2. Reset course for Intermediate Standard 1/Standard 2; walk, run Standard 1, run Standard 2. Reset course for Beginner; walk, run Standard 1, run Standard 2.

Games

The Judge will explain these games in full during the Judge's Briefing. All games are taken from *Houston's Book of Agility Games*, 4th Edition by Bud Houston. Copies of this book may be ordered from the TDAA website www.k9tdaa.com

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERSEDES THESE PRINTED BRIEFINGS.

Boston Bowling

Boston Bowling is a sequencing game that is played and scored like bowling. Each handler has two opportunities to "bowl" his dog into a tunnel (a distance send) and then run the course that corresponds to the tunnel entry the dog chooses. Running each short sequence without error will earn a "strike" bonus. Failing to successfully make the send to the tunnel is scored a "gutter ball" and uses one of the two turns. *Boston Bowling* is scored Points, Then Time.

Blackjack

Blackjack is a dog's-choice game in which the dog is directed to accumulate exactly 21 points in the fastest time. Collecting fewer than 21 points disqualifies the team; more than 21 points and the team is eliminated. *Blackjack* is scored Points, Then Time.

Jumpers

Jumpers is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up. At the judge's discretion, *Jumpers* is scored either Time, Plus Faults or Faults, Then Time.

Height Divisions

See www.k9tdaa.com for updates to Rules and height divisions.

Measured Height Divisions (Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division):

- 2" measured height ~ dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers
- 4" measured height ~ dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" measured height ~ dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" measured height ~ dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" measured height ~ dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.



Measured heights are determined based on the height of the dog at the withers. Dogs of the same measured height compete at the same course times, even when jump heights differ. Dogs of the same measured height compete against each other.

It is no longer necessary to present a jump height card when entering a TDAA trial. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

The TDAA will allow a dog's handler/owner to choose the jump height that is appropriate for that dog. If you choose a jump height HIGHER than the dog's measured height they will be scored with dogs in the higher jump height division. If you choose a jump height LOWER than the dog's measured height they will be scored with dogs in their official (measured) jump height division regardless of body-type exemption or veteran's exemption.

A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. A dog's jump height may be changed, at the trial, only with the permission of the trial secretary.

Veteran Dogs: A veteran dog is a dog of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs may jump the next lower jump height. A double-digit veteran dog is a dog of at least 10 years of age. Double digit veteran dogs may jump two jump heights lower.

Time Accommodations for Veteran Dogs & Disabled Handlers

Veteran Dogs: A veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive additional time in Standard runs based on their measured height division. Additional time in games will depend on scoring criteria. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

Disabled Handlers: Disabled handlers receive an additional 4 seconds for Standard runs. Additional time in games will depend on scoring criteria. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial. There is no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

Obstacles

The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. 2" jumps will be obtained by crossing bars on the 4" jump cups.

A-frame (6' 8") Tire Jump (20") Dog walk (8' ramps) Table (30" by 30")
Open [Pipe] Tunnel (16") Single & winged jumps (36") Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide) Weave poles (24" centers)

A **Warm up** jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.



Volunteer Sign Up

- Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. By its very nature TDAA is small. Small dogs, small equipment, small trials, and a small number of handlers. We need all hands to make a trial work. **Please sign up on the volunteer board at the trial** to work during classes you are not running in.
- We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how.

Trial Site

The trial site is indoors on mats. Indoor crating space will be available. Please bring your own crate and water.

Dogs must be on leash at all times or confined to a crate when not in the ring or warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without refund.

• Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. A refund will be given for withdrawals due to bitches in season or injured dogs. A letter from your veterinarian may be required.
- No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on an Official TDAA Agility Entry Form with one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25.00 service charge will be charged for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar, with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Exhibitors may wear clothing or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- This trial shall be judged under the current Rules and Regulations of the TDAA. Rules can be obtained online at August.k9tdaa.com.
- Dogs must be up to date on vaccinations and/or titers.

Food

There will be no food vendor on site. Several fast food and sit-down restaurants are located near the facility.

Routes to the Trial -- -- Mantayo Kennels

From the North - I-70 or 6th Avenue to Wadsworth Blvd.

Take I-70 or 6th Avenue (US 6) to Wadsworth Blvd. (CO 121) and go South. Mantayo is on the east side of Wadsworth near the intersection of Arizona Ave., however there is no left turn into the Kennels. Continue past the Kennel and make a U-turn at West Alabama Drive. The entrance will be on your right.

From the South - C-470 or US 285 to Wadsworth

Take C-470 or US 285 to Wadsworth Blvd (CO 121) and go North. Mantayo is on the east side of Wadsworth near the intersection of Arizona Ave. The entrance will be on your right.

COVID-19 Rules

We are optimistically planning for this series of mini-trials and hope to see all of you there. If any or all of the events must be canceled, exhibitors will be notified, and entry checks will be shredded.

Please understand that neither Rocky Mountain Teacup Agility nor Mantayo Kennels can completely guarantee your safety and good health. RMTA will work to adhere to all current Government and facility regulations regarding COVID. If you are unable to follow all procedures, we will ask you to leave and your entry fees will not be refunded. We want everyone to be safe and we need your help and cooperation to make this as safe as possible for everyone.

If the exhibitor or a member of their household has been diagnosed with COVID-19, we will refund entry fees for that exhibitor.

Building Occupancy: Entries are limited to **10 handlers**. To minimize the number of people on site, spectators are not allowed at this trial. Anyone not competing should stay home except in the case where a competitor requires support to trial. Everyone attending is required to sign the COVID waiver and abide by all trial rules.

Masks: The proper wearing of masks (securely covering nose and mouth) **WILL** be required at all times while within the building or within 10' of the building entry/exit. Currently, per State requirements, masks **WILL** be required during walkthroughs and while running your dog in the ring. The club will not be providing masks, so please bring your own.

Handwashing: We plan to have hand sanitizer available, but please bring your own hand sanitizer in case it is not. Whenever possible, we will periodically sanitize commonly touched areas, but please don't rely on this. Remember to **WASH YOUR HANDS** frequently.

Social Distancing: Please remember to adhere to proper social distancing at all times. This includes around the secretary/judge/ribbon/worker tables and household crating groups. Exhibitors should not be in front of the ring unless they are getting ready to run.

Maps/Results/Ribbons: We will try to have hardcopies of course maps available but please respect social distancing while collecting them. Results will be posted in a couple places. Again, please respect social distancing when viewing them. Ribbons/Stickers will not be self-serve, we will have an individual designated to hand out ribbons and stickers.

Workers: We will really need your help. Please remember to bring gloves and/or wash your hands after course building or bar setting.

Additional details will be contained in the final confirmation letter. There may be additional requirements that we have not yet considered, and requirements may change. So please keep an eye on your email for any updates on safe practice procedures in place for these events.

Instructions

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to TDAA.

NOTICE
