Obstacle Familiarization will be provided 30 minutes prior to judging.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginner/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

**All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.**

# Fall Fun Run

## Fall Fun Run - Rules

The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and the trial results correctly. By participating in the Fall Fun Run, the course you will be running will be at the Superior and Games 3 level. If you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run and you are currently at a lower level, qualifying scores will count toward those lower levels.

It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run. We will have courses designed for the lower levels that will be part of this trial, but not part of the Fall Fun Run.

Handler/dog teams may compete at more than one Fall Fun Run trial. However, ONLY the first location the handler/dog team competes at will count toward the Fall Fun Run.

Those who wish to participate in the Fall Fun Run need to know that there are two aspects to the Rules that are different for this event. The Fall Fun Run is a special event, like the Petit Prix. As a result, dogs are required to jump at their measured jump height as adjusted for any exemptions to which they are entitled. Also, no food or toys are allowed to be used in the ring.

The Fall Fun Run consists of 5 classes all run on Sunday  
Two standard runs and three games.

The results from courses run for the Fall Fun Run will include all the TDAA clubs participating.

TDAA will provide the overall Champion and Reserve Champion awards for all five scoring heights at the Superior and Games III level. Please note that the Champion and Reserve Champion per jump height will be awarded for the Fall Fun Run from all competitors nationwide. TDAA will also provide a participation rosette for each handler.

The scores will be tallied, and Champion and Reserve Champions will be announced after all trials are completed. TDAA will mail the Champion and Reserve winners their rosettes for all five scoring heights.

**PLEASE VOLUNTEER AT THE TRIAL!**

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. By its very nature TDAA is small. Small dogs, small equipment, small trials and small number of handlers. We need all hands to make a trial work. Please volunteer to work during classes you are not running in. We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through. We want everyone to have a pleasant experience running in TDAA while at the same time helping to make the trial run smoothly. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how! Help is also needed with set-up and clean-up after the trial.

**GAMES**

**Call, Direct and Send (CDS)** is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7

**Rekoons** is Snooker played backwards. Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 – 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. Rekoons is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

**Full House** is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Full House is scored Points, Less Penalty, Then Time. ER6

**Eligibility** – This trial is open to all dogs 20” or less and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance.

**CLASS INFORMATION**

**Standard Class**

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Intermediate Agility** - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games Classes**

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)**

TDAA offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.

## Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

**4" score height** - restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers.

**8" score height** - restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers.

**12" score height** – restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers.

**16" score height** – restricted to dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers.

The TDAA will allow a dog's handler/owner to choose what jump height is appropriate for that dog. That means that all jump height exemptions based on body type will go away; and jump heights will become self selecting.

**Veterans dogs** - Dogs of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive an extension in standard course time. 4" veterans receive an additional 4 seconds while 8", 12" and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

**Disabled Handlers** - Will be granted a time exemption of 4 seconds for Standard course times and 4 seconds for Qualifying course times for games classes. Proof of disability shall be the issued disability parking tag or other documentation.

There will be no special system of titling for veteran dogs or for disabled handlers.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.
- \* In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- \* Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- \* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before October 1, 2021.

**Fast Track Move-Ups:** Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with this FAST TRACK Move-Up Request form. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.**
