All equipment meets TDAA requirements.

Obstacle Familiarization will be provided on Saturday mornings 30 minutes prior to judging for all dogs and handlers.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

## **Fall Fun Run - Rules**

The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and the trial results correctly. It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run if you do not wish to do so. All qualifying runs, regardless of whether you are competing in the Fall Fun Run, will count toward regular TDAA titles.

Handler/dog teams may compete at more than one Fall Fun Run trial. However, ONLY the first location the handler/dog team competes at will count toward the Fall Fun Run.

Beginner and Intermediate dogs may run in the Superior and Games III levels to earn legs at the Fall Fun Run at their respective level. The scores for Beginner and Intermediate level dogs will only count toward the Fall Fun Run classes for this event at the Superior and Games III levels. Any additional classes that are offered by TDAA clubs, at trials hosting the TDAA 2021 Fall Fun Run, are to be run at each dog's current level. Only the five classes that are provided by TDAA are to be run at the Superior and Games III levels.

TDAA will provide the overall Champion and Reserve Champion awards for all five scoring heights at the Superior and Games III level. We will also provide a participation rosette for each handler. Only Superior/Games III classes count toward the Fall Fun Run Champion and Reserve overall awards. The scores will be tallied and Champion and Reserve Champions will be announced after all trials are completed. TDAA will mail the Champion and Reserve winners their rosettes for all five scoring heights.

## GAMES

**Eligibility** – This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20” or less at the withers and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance.

**Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.**

### CLASS INFORMATION

#### Standard Class

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

**Intermediate Agility** - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### Games Classes

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

FEO– Runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height and may run on lead. FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their level. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates and no ribbons are awarded.

#### Call, Direct, Send

Call, Direct and Send (CDS) is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7

#### Rekoons

Rekoons is Snooker played backwards. Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 – 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. Rekoons is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

#### Full House

Full House is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Full House is scored Points, Less Penalty, then Time. ER6.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas (warm-up area). It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made.**
- \* Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* **Food treats are not allowed in the ring during the Fall Fun Run event.** Toys are allowed in accordance with TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- \* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. day of the trial.

## **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. **NOTE: Dogs entered in the Fall Fun Run are required to jump at their measured height, as adjusted for any jump height exemptions they are entitled to under the Rules.** TDAA height divisions are as follows:

**ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD** must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

**2" jump height** - For dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less

**4" jump height** – For dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

**8" jump height** - For dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

**12" jump height** – For dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

**16" jump height** – For dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

### **Jump Height Exemptions**

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com) , Rules, Sec. 3.5.5 for description of height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age). You may subtract one height for Veteran status and one for Body Exemption from Measured Jump Height. Some handlers prefer to jump at other heights, as allowed under the TDAA Rules and Regulations.

**Handicapped Handlers:** Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in Standard and Games classes using numbered courses. A copy of a disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry.

## Show Site:

This trial will be held indoors on  $\frac{3}{4}$ " matting. Please bring mats for under crates.

**Exhibitors are responsible for providing a mat to put under crates and chairs to protect our surface.**

## How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificates for each dog.** Fast tracked dogs are not eligible for placement or title ribbons, but are eligible to receive Q ribbons.

Submit \$8.00 for each dog's fast track move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. If you have fast tracked before at a previous trial but have not moved up to the equivalent level based on titles earned through another organization, you may fast track at this trial by submitting the Fast Track Move Up request and fee.
