## SUPPLIES:

- 1) **Course design software** – judge candidates will be expected to use Clean Run Course Designer (CRCD) software for submission of their courses at the clinic so that their course maps are easily reviewable and easily transmitted electronically. CRCD may be purchased (recommended) or may be downloaded at [www.cleanrun.com](http://www.cleanrun.com) in a 30-day free trial version. Judge candidates will be required to complete course design assignments, which they will submit to the clinic presenter (Bud Houston) prior to the clinic.
- 2) **Courses** – judge candidates will receive course design homework to bring to the clinic. These must be completed prior to the first day of the clinic.
- 3) **TDAA Rules Book** – a copy of the TDAA rules current at the time of the clinic can be downloaded and printed from the TDAA website [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com). All participants should review a rulebook prior to the first day of the clinic and bring a copy of the rulebook.
- 4) **Measuring Wheel** – judge candidates can generally borrow a measuring wheel for use during the clinic, but may choose to buy one of their own.
- 5) **Personal Computer** – Optional – you may bring a laptop personal computer; or, at a minimum, bring course design homework on a thumb-drive.
