## TDAA Petit Prix 2015 Tournament Rules

The TDAA Rules and Regulations currently in effect on the date of competition shall be the recognized standard for rules for games and standard courses. The TDAA waives the requirement for use of the table in the standard rounds. However, use of the table is not precluded.

All dogs must be registered with the TDAA in order to compete.

A dog shall be deemed eligible to compete in the *Petit Prix* if he has competed at a TDAA trial since January 1, 2015 or if the handler is a member of the TDAA in good standing.

### **Placement, Scoring Format, and Tie-breaking**

A dog shall earn points for *placement within the field*. Points shall be accorded to the dog against the over-all field for the purpose of seeding the running order, and ranking all dogs. Scoring shall use a point table (placement inverse to count) to ensure that top performing dogs are equitably recognized.

Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be scored against dogs of the measured height and not the exemption height.

Dogs jumping with a "self-declared" height exemption beyond veteran and body-type exemptions shall *not* be eligible for placement within the tournament but shall be eligible for qualifying scores toward TDAA titles.

Scoring will be weighted, with the dog's final score adjusted by jump height. The weight factor might be applied to playing time, total combined score, or points earned. The basic weighting will be based on these values:

Dogs scored at 16" = 1.0

Dogs scored at 12" = .9

Dogs scored at 8" = .78

Dogs scored at 4" = .68

The definitive reference for agility games is *The Book of Agility Games*, which can be purchased at nominal cost at [www.dogagility.org/newstore](http://www.dogagility.org/newstore).

### **Semi-Final Competition and Qualification Notes**

All dogs, without regard to competition level, or titles earned, shall compete on the same courses. All games and courses are eligible for dogs to earn qualifying legs towards TDAA titles. Standard courses will be judged under the TDAA Superior rules. Games will be judged under TDAA Games III rules. However, the dog shall earn a qualifying score only at the level for which he is eligible.

The Semi-Finals shall include three standard courses and six games.

## **The Championship Round**

The final competition of the Petit Prix Tournament—and the Championship round— shall be the game *Helter Skelter*. The order shall be jump height and then reverse seed. Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be run at the end of that jump height. The game will be scored Time, Plus Faults.

All dogs will compete in the Championship round.

## **Championship Round Scoring**

Each dog shall enter the final round carrying all placement points earned throughout the tournament. Placement within each jump height will be based on the total accrual of those placement points. The dog with the highest total score in each jump height shall be deemed the winner and Agility Champion Teacup Dog. The top 10 placements in each jump height will be recognized.



## **GAMES**

### **Call, Direct and Send**

*Call, Direct and Send* is a numbered sequence the Call, Direct & Send course gives three opportunities for bonuses on distance challenges (a “call”, a “direct”, and “send”). *Call, Direct and Send* is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonuses.

### **Cha-Cha**

*Cha-Cha* is based on a Latin dance defined as two slow steps (anything but a jump) followed by three fast steps (jumps) the dog earns 10 points for each completed Cha-Cha bar. On any fault (including getting the steps wrong). The handler must start a new bar with his dog. *Cha-Cha* is scored Points, Then Time.

### **Four Leaf Clover**

*Four Leaf Clover* is a game in which obstacles are arranged in a pattern resembling a four-leaf clover (or, as often as not, a three-leaf clover) The dog earns bonuses for performing the leaves of the clover while the handler stays in the middle. *Four Leaf Clover* is scored points then time.

### **Helter Skelter**

Helter Skelter courses tend to start with the dogs on the table or heel at the side at the center of a clockwise spiral course. Helter Skelter is traditionally run on a Jumpers course and may contain tunnels and weave poles. Helter Skelter is scored Faults, Then Time.

### **Jumpers**

Jumpers courses consist only of hurdles and tunnels. The dog is required to run the course in the sequence indicated by the judge. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up. Scoring Jumpers is usually scored Faults, Then Time

### **Snooker**

Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. There is an opening and closing sequence. The opening can be of the handlers choosing by doing a red jump then a numbered obstacle. The closing is a numbered sequence. Snooker is scored Points, Then Time.

### **Power and Speed**

The game demonstrates the ability of the handler to exercise tight control (power) through a part of the course, and then show loose control (speed) over another part of the course. Each handler and dog runs a course that is split into two sections: Power and Speed. Power – The Power section typically consists of technical obstacles; contacts, and weave poles. The Power section may also contain spread hurdles or other specialty hurdles. Speed – The Speed section contains a straightforward Jumpers sequence. Scoring for Power and Speed is Time, Plus Faults: faults from the Power section plus time from the Speed section plus faults from the Speed section.

### **Disclaimer**

Judge’s briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will discuss in more detail the game techniques.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- \* Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified,

excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- \* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial or at the trial site of the Petit Prix. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before October 10, 2015.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded for pulling your dog for any reason other than being in season after October 1<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

### **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a lower than their proper height division. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

**2" jump height** - For dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less.

**4" jump height** - For dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

**8" jump height** - For dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

**12" jump height** - For dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; and open to all dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

**16" jump height** - Open to all dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

**E1 - Long backed dogs** – The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

**E2 - Weight to length provision** (by structure, not obesity) – This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

**E 3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs** – This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs is based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest

**A Veteran dog** is a dog at least 7 years of age. Veteran status does not alter your dog's titling status.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Handicapped exemptions: There are NO handicapped exemptions at the Petit Prix with regards to tournament scoring. The score table will need that info in case there is a special award given by a club or individual for a disabled handler. When scoring, it would be possible for the computer to add the additional time to a standard course for 'Qing' to count toward their regular title.

Veteran Dog exemptions: The score table will need that info in case there is a special award given by a club or individual. When scoring it would be possible for the computer to add the additional time to a standard run for 'Qing' at their particular level.

Neither would have extra time in games when there is a time limit. So when the briefing says small dogs have 30 seconds and tall dogs have 25 seconds for point accumulation no adjustment is made in the actual running of the ring. Everyone receives those respective times for point accumulation.

There is a maximum course time that is imposed throughout the tournament, which would be sufficient to include a SCT for beginner dogs and intermediate dogs to Q at their regular level even though they are being judged at the Superior and Games Three level.

### **TDAA National Agility Championship Title**

The Teacup Dogs Agility Association will award TDAA National Agility Championship Title (TNAC) upon the dog that: 1) achieves the highest overall score in each jump height at the TDAA Petit Prix, and 2) scores among the top 25 dogs in the tournament.

This is a unique title in our agility culture as it is a championship earned by excellence in competition; specifically, by an unambiguous win in the national tournament.
