## ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs 20" or less and over the age of 12 months, Except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

## CLASS INFORMATION

### Standard Classes

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Intermediate Agility** - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

### Games Classes

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

## GAMES

### Call, Direct & Send

In *Call, Direct & Send* the dog and handler team are challenged to solve three distance riddles on a numbered course. The three distance challenges that give the game its name include: a *Call* over one to three obstacles; a *Direct* or mid-course distance challenge of two to five obstacles; and a *Send* over two to three obstacles to close out the game.

### Rekoons

Rekoons is Snooker played backwards. Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 – 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. Rekoons is scored Points, Then Time.

### Full House

*Full House* is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Full House is scored Points, Then Time.

### Groups Choice

*Group Choice* is a game of strategy and dog's choice point accumulation game in which obstacles are divided into three different groups. Each group must be completed before moving on to the next. *Group Choice* is scored on a 100-point basis. Faults are allowed at some levels and are deducted from the 100 starting points. ER12

### Las Vegas

*Las Vegas* is a point accumulation game in which the dog builds a hand (earns points) for performing short sequences of different value. *Las Vegas* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

**Note to all handlers:** The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and the trial results correctly. It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run if you do not wish to do so. All qualifying runs, regardless of whether you are competing in the Fall Fun Run, will count toward regular TDAА titles.

If you run in the Fall Fun Run you have to run at the Superior level and at your true measured height, with any jump height exemptions.

In 2022 the TDAА Petit Prix will be presented by Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs in Maple Grove, Minnesota on July 28th-31st. Kim and Dennis Vogel are our gracious hosts for this event.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.
- \* In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- \* Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- \* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before Oct 11, 2021

## **HEIGHT DIVISIONS ("Fall Fun Runs" you need to enter in your true jump height with any jump height exemptions that apply)**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

**4" jump height** - restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

**8" jump height** - restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

**12" jump height** – restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

**16" jump height** – restricted to dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

**E1 - Long backed dogs** – The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

**E2 - Weight to length provision** (by structure, not obesity) – This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

**E3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs** – This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs in based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

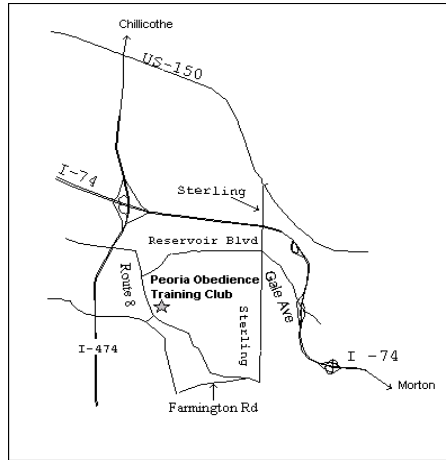
