TDAA Petit Prix 2014 Tournament Rules

The TDAA Rules and Regulations currently in effect on the date of competition shall be the recognized standard for rules for games and standard courses. The TDAA waives the requirement for use of the table in the standard rounds. However, use of the table is not precluded.

All dogs must be registered with the TDAA in order to compete.

A dog shall be deemed eligible to compete in the *Petit Prix* if he has competed at a TDAA trial since January 1, 2013 or if the handler is a member of the TDAA in good standing.

Placement, Scoring Format, and Tie-breaking

A dog shall earn points for *placement within the field*. Points shall be accorded to the dog against the over-all field for the purpose of seeding the running order, and ranking all dogs. Scoring shall use a point table (placement inverse to count) to ensure that top performing dogs are equitably recognized.

Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be scored against dogs of the measured height and not the exemption height.

Scoring will be weighted, with the dog's final score adjusted by jump height. The weight factor might be applied to playing time, total combined score, or points earned. The basic weighting will be based on these values:

Dogs scored at 16" = 1.0

Dogs scored at 12" = .9

Dogs scored at 8" = .76

Dogs scored at 4" = .60

The definitive reference for agility games is *The Book of Agility Games* which can be purchased at nominal cost at www.dogagility.org/newstore.

Competition and Qualification Notes

All dogs, without regard to competition level, or titles earned, shall compete on the same courses. All games and courses are eligible for dogs to earn qualifying legs towards TDAA titles. Standard courses will be judged under the TDAA Superior rules. Games will be judged under TDAA Games III rules. However, the dog shall earn a qualifying score only at the level for which he is eligible.

The Semi-Finals shall include three standard courses and six games.

The Championship Round

The Championship round shall be the game *Run Til You Drop*. The order shall be jump height and then reverse seed. Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be run at the end of that jump height.

All dogs will compete in the Championship round.

Championship Round Scoring

Each dog shall enter the final round carrying all placement points earned throughout the tournament. Placement within each jump height will be based on the total accrual of those placement points. The dog with the highest total score in each jump height shall be deemed the winner and Agility Champion Teacup Dog. The top 10 placements in each jump height will be recognized.

Championship Round Game

The final competition of the Tournament – and the Championship round, will be *Run Til You Drop*. This game will be scored Time, Plus Faults.



GAMES

Tag 10

The purpose of *Tag 10* is to accumulate points in 10-point blocks and to accumulate as many of those 10-point sets as possible. Sixty seconds are allotted for play. Tag 10 is scored Points, then Time.

Snooker

Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The first is dog's choice in which the dog earns the right to score three "colored" obstacles by doing a red hurdle before each. The second part is a simple sequence. *Snooker* is scored Points, Then Time.

Time Warp

The objective of *Time Warp* is to run all of the obstacles in a numbered sequence as fast as possible without faults and to turn back the clock by performing one or more Time Warp distance challenges. Time Warp is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus.

Gamblers

The objective of *Gamblers* is for the dog and handler team to accumulate as many points as possible in a specified time and then to perform a designated gamble (sometimes called a joker), also within a specified time, which consists of a sequence of obstacles with the dog and handler working some distance apart.

Lucky 13

The object of *Lucky 13* is to collect as many points as possible while correctly performing a total of 13 obstacles – no more, no less – with the thirteenth obstacle being the tire. The course design is up to the handler. Each obstacle is assigned a direction and value indicated by the cone next to it. Some obstacles may have two different point values indicated by the cones. Lucky 13 is scored Points, Less Faults, then Time.

Pinball Wizard

The goal of *Pinball Wizard* is to accumulate as many points as possible within course time. The start obstacle is the dogwalk (in either direction). After successfully completing the start obstacle, the team will continue to accumulate points by completing obstacles of the handler's/dog's choosing. Pinball Wizard is scored Points, then Time.

Run Til You Drop

Run 'Til You Drop challenges the handler to correctly estimate the dog's working speed, accumulating as many points as possible within the allotted time. Scoring and time ends on the teeter as the last obstacle (the drop!) doubling the dog's score only if time has not expired. *Run 'Til You Drop* is scored Points, Then Time.

Disclaimer

Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will discuss in more detail the game techniques.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before October 12th, 2013.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded for pulling your dog for any reason other than being in season after October 1st, 2014.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their division will be eliminated. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

2" jump height - Restricted to dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less.

4" jump height - Restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

8" jump height - Restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

12" jump height - Restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; and open to all dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

16" jump height - Open to all dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

E1 - Long backed dogs – The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

E2 - Weight to length provision (by structure, not obesity) – This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

E 3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs – This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs in based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest

A Veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs

A dog also may be given a waiver to jump at a lower height even though he does not meet any of the criteria for a jump height exemption, allowing the dog to run FEO (for exhibition only). Permission to run FEO will be given to a dog regardless of circumstance. Dogs running FEO will NOT be able to earn qualifying legs or any TDAA titles.

Handicapped exemptions: The scoretable will need that info in case there is a special award given by a club or individual for a disabled handler. When scoring it would be possible for the computer to add the additional time to a standard course for 'Qing' to count toward their regular title. It wouldn't be used in the tournament scoring.

Veteran Dog exemptions: The scoretable will need that info in case there is a special award given by a club or individual. When scoring it would be possible for the computer to add the additional time to a standard run for 'Q'ing' at their particular level. It wouldn't be used in the tournament scoring.

Neither would have extra time in games when there is a time limit. So when the briefing says small dogs have 30 seconds and tall dogs have 25 seconds for point accumulation no adjustment is made in the actual running of the ring. Everyone receives those respective times for point accumulation.

There is a maximum course time that is imposed throughout the tournament, which would be sufficient to include a SCT for beginner dogs and intermediate dogs to Q at their regular level even though they are being judged at the Superior and Games Three level.

Please be advised that entering a dog at a height lower than his eligible height will result in forfeiture of qualifying scores and tournament placements.

TDAA National Agility Championship Title

The Teacup Dogs Agility Association will award TDAA National Agility Championship Title (TNAC) upon the dog that: 1) achieves the highest overall score in each jump height at the TDAA Petit Prix, and 2) scores among the top 25 dogs in the tournament.

This is a unique title in our agility culture as it is a championship earned by excellence in competition; specifically, by an unambiguous win in the national tournament.
