Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted close to the ring and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Regarding food in the ring, here is the updated TDAA Rules and Regulations document, section 5.2.2.11:

“Use of Food Treats

The handler shall be allowed to carry and use food treats in the ring as reward for the dog so long as the food treat is not offered in a way that assists the dog in course direction or in the performance of an obstacle. The dog is faulted when the handler uses a food treat in a manner that assists the dog in course direction (standard fault) or in the performance of an obstacle (failure to perform). A food treat must be kept secure by the handler. The dog shall earn a standard fault if the handler carries food in hand while the dog is working or at any time drops a food treat on the floor or equipment.”

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Handlers must pick up after their dogs at the trial site.

Eligibility:

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this form.

Disabled Handler Exemption: Handlers who have been given disability status by their home state will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard courses and an additional 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. This is in addition to any additional time awarded through the Veteran Status Dog exemption. A copy of the handler's disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial (8:30 a.m.).

Quidditch: The objective of Quidditch is to perform three sequences and attempt to earn a bonus (the Beater) after each. The point values for each of the sequences are 15, 20, and 25 points respectively. Quidditch is scored points, then time. ER2

Louganis: A Louganis course begins with the untimed performance of two or more contact obstacles with two or more lead-out containment lines that challenge the team for an all-or-nothing scoring bonus. Time will begin only after the final contact obstacle in the opening whereupon the dog will be directed through (typically) a fast Jumpers course. Louganis is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER5

Black Hole: Black Hole is a numbered course requiring the handler to simply avoid any tunnels (Black Holes) with his dog. A dog that goes into a Black Hole is subject to a significant penalty. Black Hole is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

FAST: The Fifteen and Send Time class (FAST) is a dog's choice point accumulation game, with a distance challenge that can be attempted at any time during the run. The name of the game tells the tale of the game: perform up to fifteen obstacles and attempt the send, and do it all under time. FAST is scored points, then time. ER2

Cherry Picking:

Picking Cherries is a simple dog's choice game. The dog might be directed to as quickly as possible get all the tunnels on the course... and nothing else. Cherry Picking is scored Time Only. ER5

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. New title, TAM, TMAG and TACH ribbons are available.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered 30 minutes before the first class each day. One dog in the ring at a time.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the titles was earned. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Judge will be available to measure dogs who have not been measured. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the same. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles.

Divisions:

- **2" jump height** for dogs 4" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less.
- **4" jump height** for dogs 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less.
- **8" jump height** for dogs 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.
- **12" jump height** for dogs 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.
- **16" jump height** for dogs 20" or less at the withers.

Jump Height Exemptions

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see www.k9tdaa.com, Rules, Sec. 3.5.5 for description of height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age). You may subtract one height for Veteran status and one for Body Exemption from Measured Jump Height. Some handlers prefer to jump at their Measured rather than Actual (exemption inclusive) Jump Height.

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

Intermediate Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO – For Exhibition Only runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height and may run on lead. No treats or food are allowed. FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their level. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates and no ribbons are awarded.

Entries: entries close on October 9, 2020, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the Tuesday preceding the trial.

Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no later than 8:00 a.m. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. _____
