## **BETA DESCRIPTION**

**Standard** Beta is where you walk the course once and run it twice. In other words, Standard 1&2 are the same course and Standard 4&5 are the same course. Each level will walk their course once, run it through the line up and then the line up will run it a second time. Each run is scored separately

## **GAMES DESCRIPTIONS**

**Tag 10** *This is a dog's choice game in which the dog and handler are challenged to collect points of 10 point blocks. Faulting any obstacle erases unbanked points! Tag 10 is scored points, then time.*

**Mikey's Game** is a fun mixture of Tunnelers and What's My Line. After running a numbered course consisting of only tunnels, the handler must direct the dog to preform all of other obstacles on the field (and only once) in the order and direction of his choosing. Mikey's Game is scored Time, Plus Faults.

**Dare to Double** This is a dog's choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the obstacle is faulted! The dog must get to the finish obstacle before course time elapses or be penalized. Dare to Double is scored points, then time.

**Touch 'N Go** This course consists of contact obstacles and tunnels only. The dog must perform the obstacles in the order specified by the judge. Refusals are not faulted, and there are no jump bars to drop. All the handler has to worry about is the dog touching the contacts and staying on course. Touch 'n Go is scored faults then time. The dog with the fewest faults will win. Time is a tie-breaker only.

**Eligibility:** This trial is open to all dogs under 20” and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance.

**Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.** To register, complete the Dog Registration form and bring it with you to the trial along with a check for \$12 payable to TDAA. Or download an application at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)

If you do not have a TDAA height card or email your dog must be measured at this trial.

Measurement at the withers	Measured Jump Height	<b>No More jump height exemptions:</b> The TDAA will allow a dog’s handler/owner to choose what jump height is appropriate for their dog. <u>Dogs will place with dogs in the height class in which they measure at the withers.</u> A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. A dog’s jump height may be changed, at the trial, only with the permission of the trial secretary.

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.**

**CLASS INFORMATION**

**Standard Agility Class**

**Beginner** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Intermediate** Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) are eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior** Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) are eligible for participation in this class.

**Games Classes**

**Games I** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games II** Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Disabled Handlers** – A time exemption of 4 seconds is granted to disabled handlers for Standard course times and for qualifying course times for games class. The proof of the disability shall be the handler’s disability parking tag or other documentation. There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

A warm up area with TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization available both mornings prior to judging.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels. New Title, TMAG and TAM ribbons will also be available. Please let us know if you might earn a TMAG, TAM or TACH so we are prepared to celebrate with you!

**Move-ups:** allowed from day to day. Contact the trial secretary by the end of Saturday for Sunday changes.

**Fast Track Move-Ups:** Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move-up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move-up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move-up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move-up to the next higher class. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00** with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is nonrefundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

**FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) \$8 per run.** Dogs will run last at their jump height. They may run on lead. Runs are not counted towards TDAA titles or ribbons. FEO will have maximum time of 1.5 of SCT. No training in the ring.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and **that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.**
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or the warm-up area.
- It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made.**
- **New Rules concerning Food and toys** in the ring will be explained during the briefing by the Judge. Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com)
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Full refund for bitches in heat, if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than Wednesday, April 10, 2018.
