Note to all handlers: The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and the trial results correctly. It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run if you do not wish to do so. All qualifying runs, regardless of whether you are competing in the Fall Fun Run, will count toward regular TDAA titles.

In 2022 the TDAA Petit Prix will be presented by Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs in Maple Grove, Minnesota on July 28th-31st. Kim and Dennis Vogel are our gracious hosts for this event.

EQUIPMENT:

The following is a list of obstacles to be used at this trial:

A-Frame (6' 8" ramp, without slats and rubber surface), Dogwalk (8' without slats and rubber surface), Teeter (8' board without slats), 16" diameter Tunnels, Table (34" X 34"), Tire Jump, Weave Poles (24"), Single, Winged Jumps.

WARM-UPS: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

SCHEDULE:

Friday building will be open from 5PM for set up, Judge's briefing 6PM.

Saturday building opens at 8:30AM, first dog on the line at 9AM.

Sunday building opens at 8:30AM, first dog on the line at 9AM.

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS:

Fri PM – **Sleepy Hollow:** In this game, The handler must choose between two numbered courses (the cemetery or the long way) in order to cross the bridge before time runs out. This game is Time, plus Faults, less Bonus. ER7

Sat AM – **Call, Direct, Send:** This is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7

Sat AM – **Rekoons:** Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 – 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. *Rekoons* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Sat PM – **Full House:** *Full House* is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. *Full House* is scored Points, Less Penalty, Then Time. ER6

Sun PM – **Ladders and Snakes:** This is a numbered tunnel course (snakes) in which you must avoid taking the jumps, otherwise you have to go down a ladder (weaves). This game is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

MOVE-UPS:

Move-ups prior to the trial may be submitted by email to the trial secretary before Friday October 5th. Day of trial move-ups will be accepted in the morning before the first briefing and must be in writing.

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION:

Obstacle familiarization will take place each day prior to the judges briefing.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Light blue ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs will be offered in Standard classes. Title rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a TDAA, TAM and TMAG titles at this event. Full size TACH bars and large title rosettes also to be given for TACH. Awards will be given for High Scoring dogs in each height class, veteran dog and rescue dog. **We will also have prizes for the three highest scoring teams in the Fall Fun Match, as well as a prize for the best costume.**

FOOD

Food will be available on site Saturday and Sunday.

A suggested donation of \$10/day/person for lunches and snacks is welcome.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months, measuring 17 inches or less, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. Withdrawals will be refunded if made at least one week prior to the event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Competitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs at the trial site and hotel.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- Due to limited crating space ex-pens will NOT be allowed and crates must be stacked if possible.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or their instruments or devices
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited at the show.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in excusal from the ring.

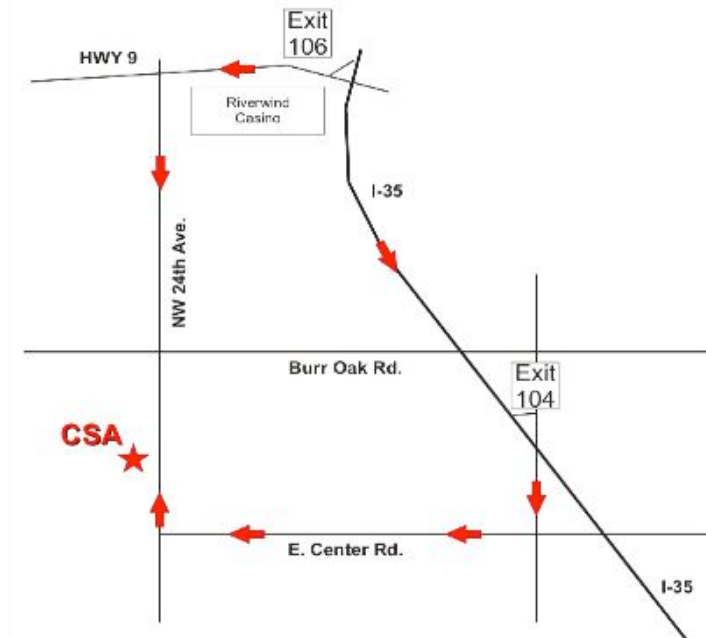

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the north: I-35 to Exit 106 Hwy 9 West at the Riverwind Casino. Go one mile toward Chickasha and turn left onto Santa Fe (also NW 24th St) then go 2.2 miles south. The Academy is on the Right.

From the west on Hwy 9 turn right onto Santa Fe (also NW 24th St) and follow the above directions.

From the south: Exit I-35 at Goldsby Exit 104 to W Interstate Drive to NW Main (Marcums Nursery & Libby's Cafe). Turn right onto Center and go straight to NW 24th . Turn right and the Academy will be on your left. This also a good choice when coming from the North as traffic is often backed up at the Casino.

I (We) agree to hold the TDAA and any TDAA approved judge harmless from any legal claim resulting from said judge's action under the TDAA Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (We) agree that the club holding the Agility Trial has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient.
