AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs completing a title will be awarded a New Title ribbon. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. **For 2021 Fall Fun Run participation rosettes will only be provided at the first location where a handler/dog team competes.**

Move Ups

Move ups earned prior to the closing date of the trial must be received by the trial secretary no later than **6PM Thursday, October 28, 2021**. All move up requests must be in writing.

Special Information for TDAA Fall Fun Run

Handler/dog teams may compete at more than one Fall Fun Run trial. However, **ONLY** the first location the handler/dog team competes at will count toward the Fall Fun Run. All qualifying legs will count toward regular TDAA titles. Only Superior/Games III classes count toward the Fall Fun Run Champion and Reserve overall awards. The scores will be tallied and Champion and Reserve Champions will be announced after all trials are completed. TDAA will mail the Champion and Reserve winners their rosettes for all five scoring heights.

In 2022 the TDAA Petit Prix will be presented by Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs in Maple Grove, Minnesota on July 28th-31st. Kim and Dennis Vogel are our gracious hosts for this event.

TO THOSE OF YOU STAYING IN AREA MOTELS

Most agility competitors are model guests, but it is becoming increasingly difficult to find motels that will accept pets due to bad experiences with excessive barking by unattended dogs. Please make it possible to have trials in this area in the future. **Never leave your dog(s) unattended in a hotel room.**

FOOD

There will be no food or drinks available at this trial. Please plan to make arrangements for your own food and drink.

COVID INFORMATION -

Each entrant will be required to sign a **COVID Waiver** in order to participate in this trial. **This will be sent out electronically following the trial closing date. ARF requires masks while you are in the building, but not while running your dog in the rung.**

Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs **20" and under** and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs must be registered with TDAA to compete. TDAA accepts pending registrations so day of show dog registrations will be accepted. If your dog has been registered with TDAA but their number has not been received, please mark pending in the TDAA number space.

The following is a list of obstacles planned for this trial:

A-frame (6' 8")	Teeter (8')

All Contacts will be rubberized.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of a regulation jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle Familiarization Handlers may take their dogs over the contact obstacles, and through the tunnel and tire from **8:15 until 8:30 Saturday morning**. Obstacle familiarization will be provided for all dogs entered in the trial on Saturday. On Sunday obstacle familiarization will be provided ONLY to entered dogs that were not entered in the trial on Saturday.

Notice to Exhibitors

- *The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- *All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring. No dogs allowed off leash outside.
- *It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- *There is no food allowed in the ring during the Fall Fun Run event.**
- *Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- *Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- *At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- *Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- *Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- *This trial shall be judged under the current Rules and Regulations of TDAA.
- *Plan to attend the general briefing since all exhibitors and their associates will be responsible for following the instructions given at that time. Failure to attend the briefing does not absolve one from conforming to club rules.

Height Division

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. **The Fall Fun Run is a regional event, and as such, dogs are required to jump at their measured height, as adjusted for any jump height exemptions they are entitled to under the Rules.** Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

*4" jump height– Restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less.

*8" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

*12" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

*16" jump height–Restricted to dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

E1 - Long backed dogs – The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

E2 - Weight to length provision (by structure, not obesity) – This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

E 3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs – This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs is based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest.

Veteran - A jump height exemption (next lower height) will be granted to veteran dogs. A veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

Class Information

Standard class

Beginning Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginning Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Game Class

Game I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Game II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Game III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (For Exhibition Only)

TDDA now offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT. FEO dogs can not repeat any obstacles and no training in the ring is allowed.

Disabled Handlers: Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4seconds in SCT in the Standard Class and in qualifying course time in Games classes. A copy of a disabled parking permit (or other official documentation) must be sent in with the entry.

Games Classes

Rekoons

Rekoons is the game Snooker played in reverse and is played as a two-part game.

Numbered Sequence: A numbered sequence must be attempted. The sequence is taken in reverse; first the #7 obstacle, then the #6, and so on, until the dog reaches the #2 obstacle.

Point Accumulation: The point accumulation period begins after the dog has completed the #2 obstacle in the opening or after having faulted. Points are earned by the completion of a red hurdle and only one scoring obstacle of the handler's choice. Each red hurdle can be used only once; and the associated scoring obstacle only if the red hurdle is not faulted. Rekoons is scored points, then time. Time is a tie-breaker only. High points wins. The qualifying run is 37 points.

Jumpers Call Direct Send (CDS)

In Jumpers CDS, a handler must call, direct, and send his dog to perform three series of obstacles. The three separate distance challenges in this game include: a call over one to three obstacles, a direct or mid-course distance challenge of two to five obstacles and a send portion over two to three obstacles to close out the game. The complexity of each distance challenge depends on the level at which the dog is competing.

Call – The Call is a lead-off at the start line, requiring the handler to call the dog over the opening obstacles. During this portion of the course, the dog is placed on a wait at the beginning of the course while the handler leads out to a point on the course designated by the judge. The handler must then call the dog over the initial obstacles and continue on course.

Direct – The Direct is a mid-course gamble sequence of 2 to 4 obstacles that the dog must perform at a distance, usually parallel to the handler. The handler must direct the dog over the sequence of obstacles without crossing a containment line indicated by the judge. Once the dog has finished the Direct portion of the course, the dog and handler can continue.

Send – The final sequence for the course is the Send. In this challenge, the objective is to see if the dog will go or send over a series of obstacles at the end of the course. The handler must not cross the containment line indicated by the judge.

Scoring Jumpers CDS is scored Points, Then Time. The team with the highest score wins. Scoring is based upon a 100 point system. 100 being perfect. Faults are deducted from the 100 points. 85 points are required to qualify. Time is used as a tiebreaker.

Full House

The objective of Full House is to successfully accumulate required points and before the expiration of time gather the elements of the Full House:

- **Three-of-a-kind** – 3 single bar jumps
- **Twosome** – 2 "circles" (tunnel, collapsed tunnel, tire or window jump)
- **Joker** – 1 contact, weaves, broad, double, or triple

All obstacles may be performed only twice for points. Back-to-back performances are allowed. The timekeeper's whistle will signal the end of point-accumulation time. At the expiration of time, the team has up to five seconds to stop the clock by going to the table or crossing the finish line. Any delay in heading for the finish line or attempting to perform any obstacle on the way to the finish line will result in the loss of the last point value earned. The team will not lose the last point value earned if the dog takes an obstacle without handler direction.

Point accumulation time differs by jump height:

- 8" and 12", whistle at 35 seconds, total game time, 40 seconds
- 16", 20" and 24", whistle at 30 seconds, total game time, 35 seconds

Full House is scored Points, Then Time.

Points for obstacles are on a 1-3-5 system:

- 1 point for Jumps
- 3 points for "Circles" (tunnel, collapsed tunnel, tire, window)
- 5 points for "Joker" (contacts, weaves, broad jump, double, and triple)
- 0 points for the table; stops the clock and is live at all times

Entries

*Entries close at 6:00 PM October 28, 2021. We will accept day of show entries until 8:30 a.m. on Saturday; there will be a \$2.00 additional fee for each run.

*Entries may be refused for any cause which the Host Club shall deem to be sufficient, including but not limited to repeated violations of TDAA or host club rules as sated in premium(s), confirmation letter(s), and/or general briefing(s).

*Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Form, one dog per entry form.

*Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20.00 service charge for any returned checks.

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

*No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

***No refund of entries withdrawn after October 28, 2021 except as specifically stated below.**

*Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$2.00 per class of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (or email) no later than 6PM Thursday October 28, 2021.

*The same refund policy will be in effect for any dog that becomes injured or seriously ill and is unable to compete. No refunds in either case without veterinarian certification.

*In the unfortunate event of the death of an entered dog, entry fees will be refunded in full.

*Refund checks will not be issued for less than \$5.00.

*Agility and Rally for Fun, its officers, directors and agents, and the owner and property manager of the facility will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any dog exhibited at this trial, to any person or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.

Fast Track

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same weekend, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. You must include documentation to prove the dogs advance titles in another organization.

A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement or title within the class that they received the qualifying score.
