ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: Your entry must be RECEIVED by **10/27/17**. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **IRDTC**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

Obstacle Familiarization - obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday morning 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs. Familiarization - one time per dog.

Warm-ups - a warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump at a minimum (and any available agility equipment without restriction) shall be provided for all Exhibitors.

Show site - Trial will be run indoors (air conditioned); Thick rubber matting; ring dimensions; Equipment is all rubberized and adheres to TDAA preferred specifications.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs **17-inches** and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-up Request Form" is set out later in premium and available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st-3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. **TITLE RIBBONS WILL BE AVAILABLE.** Fast-Track dogs **are not** eligible for awards in classes through

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may *fast track* through Beginner Agility. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may *fast track* through Intermediate Agility. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.

Superior Agility - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.

Games Classes

Games I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may *fast track* through Games I. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.

Games II - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may *fast track* through Games I. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES BEING PLAYED

Copycat

Copycat is a dog's-choice game. The handler's job is to avoid taking two obstacles, one after another, of the same point value for which the dog earns a "copycatting" fault. Copycat is scored Points, Less Faults, Then Time. ER6.

Who Dares Wins

Who Dares Wins is an exciting game of competition. Every dog works with a fixed amount of time on a numbered course; the handler must guess how far he will progress with his dog on the course which loops back on itself (so the dog can continue working if the guess requires it). The dog earns points for each obstacle performed without fault. Who Dares Wins is scored Points Only. ER2

Twelve Tone Row Twelve

Tone Row is a dog's-choice game in which exactly 12 obstacles must be performed for points. Each obstacle has a different value; and sometimes a single obstacle has different values depending on the direction taken. The 12th obstacle is required to be an obstacle designated by the judge (usually the weave poles). Twelve Tone Row is scored Points, Minus Faults, Then Time. ER6

Jumpers

Jumpers is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up. Jumpers is scored either Time, Plus Faults [ER5] or Faults, Then Time. ER12

For more information on these games the *Book of Agility Games* is available for a modest price; please visit: <http://dogagility.org/Newstore>. Our Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. Height divisions are as follows:

Dog's measurement at the withers	Regular	Veterans	With jump Height Exemption	Veterans plus Jump Height Exemption
4" and under	2"	2"	2"	2"
4.01" to 8"	4"	2"	2"	2"
8.01" to 12"	8"	4"	4"	2"
12.01" to 16"	12"	8"	8"	4"
16.01" to 20"	16"	12"	12"	8"

Note: It is no longer necessary to present a jump height card when entering a TDAA trial.

A dog's owner or handler may enter a dog at any jump height desired. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height.

Dogs given a jump height exemption will be able to earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. Dogs with a jump height exemption, including veterans, compete against dogs in the height class they measure into based on wither height.

Long-backed dogs – Based on the measurement of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of the rear compared to the dog's wither height. The dog's length must be 150% or greater than their height to qualify for this exemption.

Weight to length provision – (by structure, not obesity) This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

Dwarfish legs/deep chest – Granted to dogs whose leg to shoulder height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. Based on the dog's wither height when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from floor to chest.

Veteran dogs – A jump height exemption granted to dogs of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive an extension for Standard course times. 4" veterans receive an additional 4 seconds while 8", 12" and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

Disabled Handlers – Handlers who have been given handicap status by their home state will be granted a time exemption of 4 seconds for Standard course times and 4 seconds for Qualifying course times for time-based games classes. See TDAA rules for additional information. This additional time is in addition to any exemption given to the handler's dog due to Veteran status. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disabled parking tag or official documentation provided with the entry or presented at check-in. There will be no special system of titling for veteran dogs or for disabled handlers.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles. No training in the ring.

HOW THE FAST TRACK MOVE-UP PROGRAM WORKS

This may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II enough points in Games I to qualify for Games III. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificate for each dog.** Submit \$8.00 for each dog's move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. This Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial, even if it was paid for a previous trial.

Entries

Entries close October 27, 2017, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up and until 8:30** each morning, for \$12.00 per run. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Agreement

I/We acknowledge that the "Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules & Regulations" have been made available to me/us, and that I am/We are familiar with their contents. I/We agree to hold the TDAA, TDAA approved judge and Indian River Dog Training Club (IRDTC) harmless from any legal claim resulting from said Judge's action under the TDAA Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I/We agree that HDR has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I/We agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I/We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this Agility Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Instructions

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to TDAA.

2018 Petit Prix Tournament Rules

For the first time, dogs are required to qualify for the TDAA Petit Prix National Tournament.

In order to qualify to participate in the October 2018 Petit Prix in Washingtonville, Ohio each dog has to earn ONE Petit Prix (PPQ) run offered at local trials between September 30, 2017 and October 1, 2018.

A PPQ run for the 2018 Petit Prix Tournament will be held at this trial. All dogs registered with the TDAA are eligible to enter the PPQ run, without regard to level of competition.

The PPQ run is a Superior Standard class with no pause table, run under Superior Standard course times and judging standards. It is priced separately from the "weekend package" of regular classes.

If you qualify on that PPQ run, and you earn a qualifier toward the 2018 Petit Prix AND the Q is applied to your regular title track whatever level you are currently in. For example, a Beginner who runs and qualifies (under the Superior Standard SCT, judging criteria, and equipment list) would earn a Beginner Q toward their Beginner title and in addition to counting as their qualifier for the Petit Prix.

The Petit Prix and all PPQs must run at the dog's OFFICIAL JUMP HEIGHT. Exemptions for "Self-declared" Heights will **not** be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament or qualifying runs. A dog may jump **ANY** height on the *regular* classes at the trial, but for the purposes of qualifying for the Petit Prix, must jump his/her OFFICIAL JUMP HEIGHT in the Petit Prix Qualifier.

For example, a dog measuring 14" at the withers has an OFFICIAL JUMP HEIGHT of 12". At age 7, that dog is allowed a veteran exemption and his/her OFFICIAL JUMP HEIGHT is 8". Your dog's measured jump height is written on the TDAA entry form to determine what dogs you'll compete with for placements. You then list any official exemptions (long-backed dogs, for example) and any veteran status, and that determines your official jump height.
