Directions to show site

From Cleveland: I480 SE to Rt 14 SE for 43.9 miles. To Washingtonville, OH 44490. Turn rt onto Painters Path (next to a storage facility). South on Painters Path for 1,600 feet.

From Akron: I76 E to Rt 14 SE. Then follow above directions.

From the South: Rt 7 N. to Rt 11 N. (25.2 miles) to Rt 46. At exit ramp turn rt onto Rt 46 (2.3 miles). At first traffic light turn right on Rt 14 west (4.1 miles). Turn left onto Painters Path (next to a storage facility). Travel 1,600 feet to building site.

From I 80 Western PA: I 80 west into OH. Take Rt 11 south to SR46. Then follow directions from the south.

Painters Path is off of SR 14. It is a paved road and may not be on map quest because it is new. We are the only building on the road, so you can't miss it. Washingtonville is a speed trap, so do not drive over 35 mph. Painters Path has a speed limit of 5 mph to keep all dogs safe. To find our address using a map quest program use the address of 799 Main St. in ZIP code 44490.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts with insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to any dog 17" and under, and over the age of 12 months. Exceptions are: bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

ENTRIES CLOSE 6:00 p.m. November 7, 2017. Day of show entries will be accepted with an additional handling fee of \$2.00 per dog per day.

Games Classes

Jumpers – This is a numbered course built of jumps and tunnels. The goal of this game is to complete the course as numbered with no faults.

Near and Far - The goal of this game is to run the numbered course. At two points on the course there is a “far” section with a containment line. The idea is to send the dogs ahead to perform the obstacles on the other side of the line. Crossing the line results in 10 fault points. Games 1 dogs can cross the line once and still qualify. Games 2 and 3 dogs can not cross the line at either point. Other faults will be called if they occur.

Power and Speed – The dog and handler team run a course that is divided into two sections. The first section is the ‘power’ section and it consists of technical obstacles and is not timed. The second section of the course is the “speed” section and it is made up of jumps only. The speed section is timed. Faults from both sections are added to the timed section. Teams under course time will qualify.

Jokers Wild - This game has a series of gambles that contain one or more of the four elements (distance, direction, obstacle performance and discrimination). Each gamble is slightly harder than the previous one. The dog and handler continue on course going from gamble to gamble until they complete the entire course successfully or fail a gamble attempt and are eliminated.

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

We have nice title ribbons.

Dogs on the Fast Track are not eligible for placement ribbons in classes they Fast Track thru.

A-Frame -3’x 6’8” – Rubberized, no slats

Teeter 13”x8’ – Rubberized, no slats

Table - 36x36 - Rubberized

Tire Jump 16”diameter

Weave Poles

Single and Winged Jumps

Dogwalk 24’x 11” - Rubberized, no slats

Open (*Pipe*) Tunnel – 10’long and 12’long

Disabled Handlers:

A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler’s disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ENTRIES (FEO) – TDAA offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food allowed in the ring. There is no training in the ring, and obstacles may not be repeated. FEO teams will get 1.5 times the SCT for their level and jump height.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

WARM-UPS: A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class each day.

MOVE-UPS: Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to November 9, 2017. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

HEIGHT CARDS:

You no longer need to bring a copy of your jump height card – It is your responsibility to enter your dog in the correct height.

Class Information

Standard Class

BEGINNER AGILITY—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

GAMES II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial.

New for 2015: Each handler may select the jump height they wish their dog to jump. All jump height exemptions are now removed. Dogs will continue to be scored with dogs at their measured height. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division but will be scored in that higher height division. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

Other New rules effective January 1, 2015:

- ▣ **Removal of four-paw safety rule – a Beginner dog will no longer be required to move on after committing four paws to an obstacle and leaving. Beginner dogs will have three chances to perform a contact obstacle, and will not be faulted until a third on-and-off refusal.**
 - ▣ **Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) receive an extension of standard course time based on measured height. Measured height of 2” & 4” dogs receive an additional 4 seconds. Measured heights of 8”, 12” & 16” dogs receive an additional 2 seconds**
 - ▣ **Disabled Handlers receive an extension of 4 seconds to standard course times and qualifying course times for games. The proof of the disability shall be the handler's disability parking tag or other documentation.**
 - ▣ **There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers or veteran dogs.**
- Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter. If you do not have a TDAA card you will need to be measured at this trial.**

WE NOW HAVE TURF IN OUR AGILITY RING. THERE WILL BE A \$15 CHARGE FOR ANY POTTY ACCIDENTS IN THE RING TO COVER CLEANING COSTS. This rule is at the management's discretion.

Entries close at 6:00 pm on November 7, 2017 after which time entries cannot be canceled, altered, or substituted.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are *not* acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are *not* acceptable. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but five dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, then qualifies again in Intermediate.

Likewise, a dog may move up from Games I to Games III by earning qualifying scores at each of the lower two levels.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

Please mark each of the following that apply:

- Move up from Beginners to: Intermediate Superior
- Move up from Games I to: Games II Games III

Submit \$8.00 with your move-up request, and attach this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have four chances at each), and is non-refundable. This Fast Track Fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for at a previous trial.

The Qualifying round will be judged under Superior rules for performance, using Superior rates of travel. Body type and veterans height exemptions shall be scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. Exemptions for "Self-declared" heights will not be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament.
