**From the East or West:** I-72 to Exit 138 (Decatur/Lincoln Exit)

At the end of the exit ramp turn right (North-West) onto SR 121.

Stay on 121 for 3.5 Miles. Turn left (west) onto (E) Main St. at the first blinking light. Travel on E Main about 0.4 miles to stop sign. Turn left across railroad tracks to stop sign. Turn left at stop sign. Show site is across the street from the Barclay Public Library.

**From the North:** US Highway 51 South to I-72. West on I-72 and follow directions above.

### Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is

expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in or close to the ring and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Handlers must pick up after their dogs at the trial site.

### Eligibility :

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

### Games Classes

**Colors** Colors is a sequencing game. The handler has a choice of running any one of three short courses that are woven together on the field. Colors is scored Faults, Then Time.

**Dare to Double** Dare to Double is a dog's-choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course (traditionally the A-frame) as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the A-frame is faulted! The dog must get to the finish obstacle before course time elapses or be penalized. Dare to Double is scored Points, Then Time.

**Near & Far** Near and Far is a simple sequencing game with two modest distance challenges. For the most part the handler can run along with his dog (Near); but in the distance challenges the dog must work away (Far). Near and Far is scored Time, Plus Faults.

**Tag 10** Tag 10 is a dog's choice game in which the dog and handler are challenged to collect points in 10 point blocks. Faulting any obstacle erases unbanked points! Tag 10 is scored points, then time.

**Octagon Game** . The Octagon Game has the dog performing a series of obstacles arranged in the shape of an octagon. On any fault the dog is required to do a set of weave poles positioned in the center of the octagon. The Octagon Game is scored time only.

**Judge's briefing, given 15 minutes prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions of how to play the game.**

**Entries:** Entries close at 6:00 PM, December 4, 2017 after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the Tuesday preceding the trial.

Day of event entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$5.00 per day. **Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no less than 8:15 a.m..** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

### How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

## RULES FOR THE 2018

# TDAA PETIT PRIX TOURNAMENT

TDAA's 2018 Petit Prix championship tournament is designed to showcase top competitors among dogs of small stature in the sport of dog agility and to name a tournament champion in each jump height.

The Qualifying Period for the 2018 Tournament Season is October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018.

Each tournament is structured on two levels:

1. Regional qualifying events held during the Qualifying Period

2. A championship event consisting of Semi-Finals and the Championship Round, to be held at Four Seasons K9 Athlete Center, Washingtonville, Ohio; October 5-7, 2018.

## General Rules

This tournament is designed to provide a test in head-to-head competition with challenges that generally conform to the Course Design Guidelines of the Superior Standard class. Emphasis will be on challenges at speed, appropriate for dogs competing at an advanced level.

Competitors are eligible to compete in the tournament series with any dog that is registered with TDAA without regard to previous accomplishments in the sport. These general rules apply:

- Any competitor may enter any of the Regional qualifying trials without regard to geographic location.
- Qualifications earned in regional qualifying events and each round of the Petit Prix are recorded for titling at the level for which the dog is eligible.

## Qualification, Eligibility & Advancement

TDAA Rules & Regulations currently in effect at the date of competition shall apply. Standard scoring rules for the Superior standard class as set forth in the TDAA Rules and Regulations shall apply. A qualifying score shall be awarded for a zero-fault round.

- A Regional qualifying class shall consist of a single round on a standard course. A qualifying score in the class is required to qualify for the Petit Prix.
- Any dog entered in the Petit Prix tournament that does not have a completed official measurement (two measurements

that agree) placing the dog in a specific measured height, must be measured prior to competing in the Petit Prix.

- Body type and veterans height exemptions shall be scored with their measured height without benefit of handicapping. Exemptions for “Self-declared” heights will not be recognized for play in the Petit Prix tournament.

## **Semi-Finals Placement, Scoring Format, and Tie-breaking**

A dog shall earn tournament points in two ways:

1. *Placement within the field.* Performance points shall be accorded to the dog against the over-all field. Scoring shall use a point table (placement inverse to count) to ensure that top performing dogs are equitably recognized.
2. *Top scoring dogs*[\[1\]](#). Exceptional performance points shall be earned for the top five placements against the field, for each class, to be awarded on this basis:
  1. 1<sup>st</sup> Place 25 points
  2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place 20 points
  3. 3<sup>rd</sup> Place 15 points
  4. 4<sup>th</sup> Place 10 points
  5. 5<sup>th</sup> Place 5 points

Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be scored against dogs of the measured height and not the exemption height; and will compete using the scoring times set for the measured height.

Scoring will be weighted, with the dog’s final score adjusted by jump height. The weight factor might be applied to playing time, total combined score, or points earned. The basic weighting will be based on these values:

Dogs scored at 16” = 1.0

Dogs scored at 12” = .95

Dogs scored at 8” = .89

Dogs scored at 4” = .82

## **Competition, Placement and Qualification Notes**

The Petit Prix Semi-Finals will consist of four standard courses and six games.

The top *five* placements in each jump height will be recognized in the award ceremony. The winner of each game and standard round through the tournament, measured against the entire field of dogs, shall be recognized and awarded a winner’s prize.

All dogs, without regard to competition level, or titles earned, shall compete on the same courses. All games and courses are eligible for dogs to earn qualifying legs towards TDAA titles. All courses will be judged under the TDAA Superior rules for performance. However, the dog shall earn a qualifying score only at the level for which he is eligible.

Course Time differentials for Beginner/GI, Intermediate/GII, Vet Dog, or Disabled Handler will not be used for Tournament Scoring. These differentials *may* be used by the score table to determine if a team earns a qualifying score at the level for which they are eligible and for any Special Awards for the event. Any maximum course times used will accommodate this. Some games have scoring criteria where these additional time allowances will not apply.

# Games

In addition to four standard classes, the Petit Prix competition shall consist of these six games:

1. *Just In Time* is a dog's-choice point accumulation game in which the dog earns special bonuses for ending in a timely manner. *Just in Time* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2
2. The *Steeplechase* is a numbered sequence typically featuring the A-frame and the weave poles (once of which must be taken twice). A *Steeplechase* is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5
3. *Pole Jacks* is a game of strategy and skill, played like the children's game of jacks. The performance of a short set of weave poles is the bounce of the ball! *Pole Jacks* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2
4. *The Weakest Link* is a dog's choice point accumulation game that requires a handler to "bank" points to keep them; or lose points that are not banked. In this game points earned must be worth as much as or more than the last points earned; and are safe only when banked. Often there will be a distance challenge accorded an extraordinary bonus value. *The Weakest Link* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2
5. *Jumplers* is a combined class of *Jumpers* and *Gamblers*. The dog will run a numbered course consisting of jumps and tunnels that will feature elements on which the dog will earn bonuses for working at a distance from the handler. *Jumplers* is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7
6. *Quidditch* is a simple game of handling skill. The handler must direct the dog to perform three sequences of escalating value, and attempting the simple performance of

a tire after each. The game is full of interesting bonuses and colorful phraseology. *Quidditch* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

## The Championship Round

The Championship round shall be a standard course. And placement within this round solely shall determine placement in each jump height for the Petit Prix Tournament<sup>[2]</sup>.

Dogs that will compete in the Championship round shall include:

- The top twenty-five dogs by placement in the field;
- The winner of each individual event;
- The top scoring dog in each jump height.

The order shall be jump height and then reverse seed. Dogs running with a jump height exemption shall be run at the end of that jump height.
