GAMES

Eligibility – This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20” or less at the withers and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.

There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

FEO– Runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height and may run on lead. FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their level. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates and no ribbons are awarded.

Copycat

Copycat is a dog’s-choice game. The handler's job is to avoid taking two obstacles, one after another, of the same point value for which the dog earns a "copycatting" fault. Copycat is scored Points, Less Faults, Then Time. ER6.

Last of the Mohicans

Last of the Mohicans is a game of strategy and daring. The objective is get from the homestead to the fort while performing as many obstacles as possible on the field without ever stopping, going back to correct a missed obstacle, or without allowing the dog to ever cross over his own path. One point is earned for each obstacle performed. Last of the Mohicans is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Tunnelers

Tunnelers is a numbered course consisting only of tunnels. Dogs at all levels run the same course. Tunnelers is scored Faults, Then Time. ER12

**JUDGE’S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL
SUPERCEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas (warm-up area). It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made.**
- * Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- * Food and toys are allowed in the ring in accordance with TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. day of the trial.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Judge will be available to measure dogs who have not been measured. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. TDAA height divisions are as follows:

ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

2" jump height - For dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less

4" jump height – For dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

8" jump height - For dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less.

12" jump height – For dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less.

16" jump height – For dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

Jump Height Exemptions

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see www.k9tdaa.com , Rules, Sec. 3.5.5 for description of height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age). You may subtract one height for Veteran status and one for Body Exemption from Measured Jump Height. Some handlers prefer to jump at other heights, as allowed under the TDAA Rules and Regulations.

Handicapped Handlers: Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in Standard and Games classes using numbered courses. A copy of a disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry.

Show Site:

This trial will be held indoors on $\frac{3}{4}$ " matting. Please bring mats for under crates.

Exhibitors are responsible for providing a mat to put under crates and chairs to protect our surface.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificates for each dog.** Fast tracked dogs are not eligible for placement or title ribbons, but are eligible to receive Q ribbons.

Submit \$8.00 for each dog's fast track move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. If you have fast tracked before at a previous trial but have not moved up to the equivalent level based on titles earned through another organization, you may fast track at this trial by submitting the Fast Track Move Up request and fee.

Agreement

I (We) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Agility Trial, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
