Location / Directions to Show Site

Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs is located northeast of Minneapolis off Highway 610 in Osseo, Minnesota. From highway 169 North or South, take the exit to 610 West. Take Zachary Ln exit. Take the first traffic circle $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around heading south. Go straight through the next traffic circle continuing on Zachary Ln South to 95th Ave. Turn right onto 95th Ave. Take a right turn onto 96th Ave. N. Continue all the way to the back of the last building and turn left. Cloud Nine is the last suite in the northeast corner.

Airport: Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport is the closest airport to the site (about 30 miles).

Volunteer Sign Up

Sponsorships

Any TDAA members or clubs wishing to sponsor an award should contact TDAA by May 15, 2022. All sponsored awards must be approved by TDAA and cannot include "TDAA" "National" or "Champion", nor can it substantively duplicate a TDAA award. They must be objectively determined and cannot be won by the sponsor. No cash awards will be approved.

Tournament Eligibility and Class Information

The Friday runs are open to all dogs at all levels, measuring 20 inches and under, over the age of 12 months.

The Petit Prix event on Saturday and Sunday is open to dogs who: have participated in a TDAA trial any time between April 1, 2021 and May 15, 2022; have earned the TIAD and Games 2 titles; measure 20 inches and under; and are over the age of 12 months. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical performance are not allowed in any TDAA event. Please note that 3-legged dogs *are* permitted in the TDAA, and a missing leg is not considered an injury.

Dogs eligible to play in the TDAA are further defined in the [TDAA Rules and Regulations](#). (v. 5.8.2).

CLASS INFORMATION

Friday – Fun Day as you prepare for the Petit Prix:

The activities on Friday, while not strictly part of the Petit Prix competition, are designed to engage handlers and dogs at all levels. There will be two classes on Friday that are open to dogs at all levels, including those dogs who are not competing in the Petit Prix on Saturday and Sunday: one standard run and one game. There is also the Tunnel Challenge (description and rules forthcoming) and the Raffle will begin. Additionally, on Friday you will have the opportunity to check in, catch up with others at the tournament, see the facility, and get acclimated for the weekend.

The Friday game is *Lucky 13*, which is a dog's choice game where obstacles are laid out on the field valued from 1 point to 20 points. The dog may do only 13, without repeating any; earning the value of the assigned numbers as they work. *Lucky 13* is scored Points, Less Faults, Then Time. ER6

Saturday and Sunday – The Petit Prix Tournament

The Petit Prix tournament will include three standard courses and three games to be run on Saturday and Sunday. Standard courses will be run using Superior rules for performance, including rates of travel. Any qualifying score will be accorded at the dog's respective level.

The Petit Prix competition shall consist of these three games:

1. *Penny Arcade*. The objective of *Penny Arcade* is to accumulate points before the expiration of time either by taking individual obstacles for single point values or by playing the arcade games to activate bonus point values. *Penny Arcade* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2
2. *Four-Leaf Clover* is a game in which the dog earns bonuses for performing sequences (the leaves of the clover) while the handler stays in the middle. *Four Leaf Clover* is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7
3. *Boomerang* is a game where the dog must perform obstacles to accumulate points. Once the dog goes through the red tunnel if he returns on the same path to the start of that sequence, he will receive a bonus for a successful "Boomerang Throw". *Boomerang* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Awards

Trial rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement rosettes without qualifying.

Tournament awards will be:

- 1st through 4th place in each class
- For the overall tournament at each jump height, 1st through 5th will be awarded. This includes the TDAA National Agility Championship Title (TNAC) to the 1st place dog. Awards include a rosette and a trophy for the TNAC, and placement rosettes for 2nd through 5th place.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the Teacup Dogs Agility Association, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to crate outside, or even be expelled from the tournament. In cases of aggression/expulsion, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Squeaky toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, verbal abuse of trial personnel, or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring, and possibly expulsion from the tournament.

Show hours are approximately 11:00 am to 6:00 pm Friday and 7:30 am to 6:00 pm Saturday and Sunday or until finished. Judging will start at noon on Friday, and 8:30 on Saturday and Sunday.

- ENTRIES CLOSE 6:00 p.m. June 15, 2022.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent payment to the TDAA shall be on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. The club will refund all but 10% of the entry fee for dogs unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before July 12, 2022.
