**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- **ENTRIES CLOSE at Midnight Central Time, December 1, 2023.**
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or the designated agility warm-up area.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to crate outside or even be expelled from the trial. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices. Food and toys are allowed in the ring, in accordance with TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal.
- **Handlers must pick up after their dogs at the trial site.**

## ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers, over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

### **Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.**

**Veteran Dogs:** A veteran dog is a dog of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive additional course time in standard runs and games that are timed. 4" (measured height) veterans receive an additional 4 seconds, while 8", 12", and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

A double-digit veteran dog is a dog of at least 10 years of age. Double-digit veteran dogs receive 2 seconds in addition to what a veteran dog receives for standard courses and for games that are timed.

**Disabled Handler Exemption:** Handlers who have been given disability status by their home state will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard courses and an additional 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. This is in addition to any additional time awarded through the Veteran Dog exemption. A copy of the handler's disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

## GAMES THAT ARE PART OF THIS TRIAL

**Jumpers:** Jumpers is a favorite game in the dog agility world. Courses are made up of jumps and tunnels only, so the play is fast and furious. Follow the numbers and keep the bars up. Jumpers is scored Faults, Then Time. ER12

**Tunnelers:** Tunnelers is a numbered course consisting only of tunnels. Dogs at all levels run the same course. Tunnelers is scored Faults, Then Time. ER12

**Group Choice:** Group Choice is a game of strategy and dog's choice point accumulation game in which obstacles are divided into three different groups. Each group must be completed before moving on to the next. Group Choice is scored on a 100-point basis. Faults are allowed at some levels and are deducted from the 100 starting points. ER12

**Four Leaf Clover:** Four Leaf Clover is a game in which obstacles are arranged in a pattern resembling a four-leaf clover. The dog earns bonuses for

performing the leaves of the clover while the handler stays in the middle. Four Leaf Clover is scored Points, Plus Bonus, Less Faults. ER8

**Twister:** Twister is a point accumulation game in which the dog earns points for sequences of obstacles arranged in two concentric loops. The dog is required to change the direction of play between scoring sequences, alternating between the inner and outer loops. Bonus points are awarded for a faultless performance. Twister is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

**Cha-Cha:** Cha-Cha is a game that requires the dog to earn points to the beat of the Cha-Cha: two slow beats (non-jump obstacles) followed by three quick beats (jumps). This is a game of strategy and precision. Cha-Cha is scored Bars (Points), Then Time. ER2

**Table Jacks:** Table Jacks is a game of strategy and skill, played like the children's game of jacks. The performance of the table is the bounce of the ball. All other obstacles on the course are jacks and have specific point values. After the bounce the team begins with "onsies" then "twosies"... and all the way through "sevensies", time permitting. Table Jacks is scored Points, then time. ER2

**Power and Speed:** Power and Speed is a two part game. In the first part [Power] the dog will run an un-timed sequence of mostly technical obstacles; and in the second part [Speed] the dog will run a timed jumpers course. Power and Speed is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

**Cherry Picking:** Cherry Picking is a simple dog's choice game. The dog might be directed to as quickly as possible get all the tunnels on the course... and nothing else. Cherry Picking is scored Time Only. ER5

**Blackjack:** Blackjack is a dog's-choice game in which the dog is directed to accumulate 21 points in the fastest time; going over 21 points disqualifies the team. During point accumulation the dog must score at least one obstacle from three obstacle types. Blackjack is scored Points, Then Time. ER10

**The judge's briefing, given prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions and the written briefings of how to play any game.**

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. New title ribbons are also available.

**Warm-Ups:** A warm up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered 30 minutes before the first class each day. One dog in the ring at a time.

**Move-Ups:** Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

Single Jumps    Tire Jump (16")  
All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements

#### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

TDAA offers the following Jump Height Divisions: 2", 4", 8", 12", 16". Owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog at the proper height division, both the dog's measured jump height and the height at which they want their dog to jump at the trial. Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

**Veteran Dogs** – Veteran dogs receive additional time in Standard and timed Games runs based on their measured height division. Double-digit veteran dogs receive an additional extension in Standard and timed Game course time. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

**Disabled Handlers** – Disabled handlers receive an additional 4 seconds for Standard and timed Games runs. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the

handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial. There is no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

#### **Standard Class**

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs are eligible for participation in this class.

**Intermediate Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) are eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) are eligible for participation in this class.

#### **GAMES CLASSES**

**Games I** – All dogs are eligible for participation in this class.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) are eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) are eligible for participation in this class.

**FEO**– For Exhibition Only runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height and may run on lead. FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their level. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates, and no ribbons are awarded.

#### **ENTRIES**

**ENTRIES CLOSE at Midnight Central Time, December 1, 2023.**

Entries will be allowed on the day of the trial, before judging begins. Entries without fees will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached will not be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted and cannot be entered in the Trial. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in them being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil

disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by the Friday preceding the trial.

**Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no later than 8:00 a.m.** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

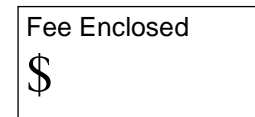
