Entries: Entries will be allowed on the day of the trial, before judging begins. Entries without fees will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached will not be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are will not be accepted and cannot be entered in the Trial. Credit cards payments cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in them being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no later than 9:30 a.m. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers and TDAA Membership may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Running Order: Superior to Beginner, Small to Tall

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each class

Orange ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score

Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying

Dogs getting a new title will receive a title rosette

Measuring, Familiarization and Check In: 8:00am to 8:30am, Judge's Briefing to follow

Lunch: The Café has beverages as well as sweet and savory food items for sale. You are also welcome to place orders and have delivery (or pick up) and eat in the Café.

- Exercise your dog responsibly! Please pick up after your dog at the show site and hotels
- All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm up area
- COVID REQUIREMENTS: The final confirmation will include any requirements for masking dependent upon rates in the week prior to the trial. You are always welcome to mask.

Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers, over the age of 12 months. The trial is not open to aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Bitches in season are only permitted in the trial with prior approval from the Trial Chair. In such a case, the dog must wear a protective garment.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this trial premium. TDAA Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at k9tdaa.com

Veteran Dogs: A veteran dog is a dog of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive additional course time in standard runs and games that are timed. 4" (measured height) veterans receive an additional 4 seconds, while 8", 12", and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

A double-digit veteran dog is a dog of at least 10 years of age. Double-digit veteran dogs receive 2 seconds in addition to what a veteran dog receives for standard course time and for games that are timed.

Disabled Handler Exemption: Handlers who have been given disability status by their home state will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard courses and an additional 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. This is in addition to any additional time awarded through the Veteran Dog exemption. A copy of the handler's disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Standard Class

Beginner Agility—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class

Intermediate Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class

Superior Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. (Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class)

Games Class

Games I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Trial Games

Triathlon: *Triathlon* is a combination game incorporating Snooker, Jumpers and Gamblers. *Triathlon* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Beat the Clock: *Beat the Clock* is a sequencing game in which the obstacles are arranged in four parts, like quadrants of the clock. Obstacles are typically arranged around the tire. The handler is required to do the tire before each of the quadrants. *Beat the Clock* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Stop the Clock: *Stop the Clock* is a fun point accumulation game with a twist. On each performance of the tire the dog can stop the clock and reposition the dog on course for scoring purposes. Time resumes when the dog begins the performance of another obstacle. *Stop the Clock* is scored points then time. ER2

The judge's briefing, given prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions and the written briefings of how to play any game.*

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. New title, TAM, TMAG and TACH ribbons are available.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered 30 minutes before the first class each day. One dog in the ring at a time.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

Rubberized A-frame (7')
Rubberized Dog Walk (8' slatless)
Weave Poles (22" center)
Single and Winged Jumps

Open (Pipe) Tunnels (16")
Teeter (8')
Table (35"x35")
Tire Jump (16")

FEO (For Exhibition Only)

FEO (For Exhibition Only): TDAA offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO teams will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO dogs cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$30 for returned checks. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be always on leash except when using the warmup area or in the agility ring per state leash laws.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
