DIRECTIONS

FROM SOUTH: Coming from I-65, take I-265 E (Exit 125A) to Bardstown Rd. Exit (Exit 17). Take Bardstown Rd. West (left) toward Louisville. Go approximately 3.5 miles and Agility Cues for You will be on your left in the Eastland Shopping Center (at the corner of Bardstown Rd., and S. Watterson Trail. There is a stop light at the turn into the strip mall. If you get to Breckinridge Lane you have gone too far.

FROM NORTH: Coming from I-71, take I-265 W (Exit 9A) to Bardstown Rd. Exit (Exit 17). Take Bardstown Rd. East (right) toward Louisville. Go approximately 3.5 miles and Agility Cues for You will be on your left in the Eastland Shopping Center (at the corner of Bardstown Rd., and S. Watterson Trail. There is a stop light at the turn into the strip mall. If you get to Breckinridge Lane you have gone too far.

FROM EAST: Coming from I-64, take I 265 W (Exit 19A) to Bardstown Rd. Exit (Exit 17). Take Bardstown Rd. East (right) toward Louisville. Go approximately 3.5 miles and Agility Cues for You will be on your left in the Eastland Shopping Center (at the corner of Bardstown Rd., and S. Watterson Trail. There is a stop light at the turn into the strip mall. If you get to Breckinridge Lane you have gone too far.

FROM WEST: Coming from I-64, take Hurstbourne Parkway exit #15, turn right onto Hurstbourne Parkway, go around 3.5 miles and turn right onto S. Watterson Trail, go about 1 mile and go straight at the light, building is immediately on your right in the Eastland Shopping center.

Early Bird Discounts You are entitled to a \$2.00 per run discount if you submit your entry by the **Early Discount** date of January 31, 2017. All Entries received after January 31, 2017, will not receive the Early Bird Discount of \$2.00/run. We are offering package deals for all listed classes of \$120 (if entry not received by Early Bird deadline) and \$100 (if entry received by Early Bird deadline).

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which requires a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms. One dog per entry form. **Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAA Agreement attached are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules and Regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.

- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of weather, riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the Show Committee.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$35.00 for returned check. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any Exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring and possibly the trial.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or the agility ring.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations of TDAA.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and the Trial Site.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.
- **PLASTIC MATS OR TARPS MUST BE PLACED UNDER AND AROUND YOUR DOG'S CRATE.**

Obstacle Familiarization – obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday, and Sunday approximately 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs.

Warm-ups – a warm-up area, consisting, at a minimum, of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for all Exhibitors.

Eligibility – this Trial is open to all dogs **20-inches and under** at the withers and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to early bird date. Move-up requests must be in writing, but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. Move-Up Request Form will be available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS - Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Fast-Track dogs **are not** eligible for awards in classes through which they Fast-Track. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Classes

BEGINNER AGILITY --All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this Class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But, see Rules for Fast-Track titling.)

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY--Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY--Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

Games Classes

GAMES I --All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations. (But see Rules for Fast-Track titling.)

GAMES II-- Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this Class. (But see Rules for Fast-Track titling.)

GAMES III --Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this Class.

FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs - will be allowed. Teams running FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times the Standard Course time in the ring. The dog may be on a leash, as long as the handler is careful not to get it caught on any obstacle while in the ring. Teams may not repeat any contact obstacles (no training allowed) while running FEO. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA title or certificates. ***No treats or food allowed in ring.***

Disabled Handlers – A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the Trial.

Height Divisions -Owners are responsible for indicating the proper height division on the entry form. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. Provisional dogs must be measured by a Judge. Special provisions are made granting body-type and veteran dogs jump height exemptions. **A dog's owner or handler may enter a dog at any jump height desired.** A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. Dogs run at desired jump height, but compete at their measured jump height, and veterans receive an extended course time. Standard height divisions are as follows:

- 2" jump height for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 8" or less
- 4" jump height for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less
- 8" jump height for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less

- 12" jump height for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 20" or less
- 16" jump height open to dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

ALL DOGS NOT POSSESSING A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD WILL NEED TO BE MEASURED PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF COMPETING AT THIS TRIAL. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO ARRIVE EARLY ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE MEASURING

PLEASE READ! How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

Dogs may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificate for each dog.** Submit \$8.00 per trial for each dog's move-up request **PER TRIAL, not per class.** Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. **This Fast Track fee must be paid for this Trial, even if it was paid for a previous trial**

GAMES CLASSES BRIEFINGS

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL, SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS

WILDCARD--A Wildcard course is run like a standard agility course. The dog is required to perform a sequence designated by the judge. However, at three designated points on the course the handler, or possibly the dog, will have a choice of which obstacle, out of 2 obstacles, to perform for that number in the sequence. This is called a Wildcard.

TAG 10-- The purpose of Tag 10 is to accumulate points in 10-point blocks and to accumulate as many of those 10-point sets as possible. Sixty seconds are allotted for play. Tag 10 is scored points, then time.

SPECIAL NOTES

Please note that parking has changed for all AQ4U events. Per our landlord, we must park in front of the strip mall. There is plenty of parking available in front of the strip mall.

Set-up for the trial is Friday at 6:00. \$5 in AQ4U Bucks is offered for those who help, and you get your crating spot saved. We are usually done by 7:00.

Beta format means there will be two runs over the same course. Walk once, run twice
